

## NOTICE OF ELECTION

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA

BEAUFORT COUNTY

There will be a special election on Tuesday, May 31, 2022, to fill a vacated seat for the Hilton Head Island Public Service District (PSD), Voting District 4.

Any person wishing to vote in this election must register:

**In-person:** No later than 5:00 pm Friday, April 29, 2022

**Email, Fax, or Online:** No later than 11:59 pm Sunday, May 1, 2022

**By Mail:** Must be postmarked by Monday, May 2, 2022

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs when voting absentee in person and at their polling place.

- S.C. Driver's License
  - Includes standard License and REAL ID
- S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles ID Card
  - Includes standard ID card and REAL ID
  - Includes SC Concealed Weapons Permit
- S.C. Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
  - Includes all Department of Defense Photo IDs and Veterans Affairs Benefits Card
- U.S. Passport
  - Includes US Passport ID Card

If you have one of these Photo IDs, you are ready to vote. Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from the Department of Motor Vehicles or their county voter registration office. Voters who encounter an obstacle to getting a Photo ID should bring their paper voter registration card without a photo with them to their polling place. These voters can then sign an affidavit swearing to their identity and to their obstacle to obtaining a Photo ID and vote a provisional ballot. This ballot will count unless the county board of voter registration and elections has grounds to believe the affidavit is false. At 9:00 a.m. on May 31, 2022, the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County will begin its examination of the absentee ballot return envelopes at the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County's Beaufort Office, located at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, SC 29906 (843) 255-6900.

At 11:00 am on June 2, 2022, the Board of Voter Registration Elections of Beaufort County's Board of Canvassers will hold a canvass hearing to determine the validity of all provisional ballots cast in the election. The hearing will be held at the Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County's Beaufort Office, located at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, SC 29906 (843) 255-6900.

The following precincts and polling places will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.
