Consistency With Other Data

C of C Estimates of Gross Sales to Island Visitors of \$890M and Survey of Visitors Arriving at HXD of 2%

Wallhaus Analysis: % of HXD Visitors \$19.3M/\$890M= 2.2%

Wilbur Smith Analysis: % of HXD Visitors \$42.6M/\$890M=4.8%
