The public is invited to attend an open house on Saturday, Aug. 15, 2020, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Beaufort County Airport, 39 Airport Circle, Lady's Island, where a commemorative ceremony will

- ❖ Eagle Scout Flagpole Project at ARW: There was an improvement project completed by the Boy Scouts which consisted of building of retaining wall, installing a paver patio to enhance the airport building. We are grateful to the scouts who donated their time and labor and the local businesses who donated equipment and materials. Director's Report – Hilton Head Island Airport Project Update

- ❖ Hilton Head Island-Bluffton Chamber of Commerce - Path Forward Readiness Plan: The Hilton Head Island-Bluffton Chamber of Commerce, in partnership with the business community, town governments and residents, established the Path Forward Readiness Plan. This plan includes best practice protocols designed to help reduce the risk of virus transmission. Learn more through the Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC). Hilton Head Island Airport and Signature Flight Support took the pledge seal and promised to create a safe and clean environment for travelers to explore and enjoy “America’s Favorite Island”.
- ❖ Airlines trends –The flight numbers have picked up since May. American Airlines added more flights over the weekend (DFW, PHL and ORD). There are no restrictions on their seat capacity. Delta is self-restricting capacity by selling just 60% of their seats. We continue to monitor trends at the airport in light of Covid-19.
- ❖ Hilton Head Island Airport Path Forward Digital Marketing Program: Hilton Head Island Airport has been working with Hilton Head Island – Bluffton Chamber of Commerce to begin a 6-month digital campaign program for the development of the airport. This is an effort to increase brand awareness, offer value-add promotions and enhance airport customer experience. This campaign is starting this week and we are hopeful to see good results.
- ❖ Part 139 Inspection: Annual FAA’s airport certification safety physical inspection still to be determined. Meanwhile, electronic documents have been submitted to FAA. More to follow soon.
- ❖ Projects Update:
 - HXD Commercial Terminal
 - Grant 45 received \$10,000,000.00
 - Funding Gap – We encourage all our board members to work with their state and county legislators and request that they support continued funding of Hilton Head Island Airport and ongoing projects. There is a federal relief money coming to the states in response to

the pandemic. Hilton Head Island Airport has to continue to support its tourism economy by completing of expansion of the commercial terminal.
