Old Business

We have not received any word from the appeal made to Judge Dukes in reference to the contract. Attorney Fred Kuhn is going to write and letter to the City and Town reminding them that the contract payments for this year are due March 1st and also that our contract expires 12/31/17.

New Business

Opticom – There is a GPS system installed in most traffic lights in the county that when activated, turns the light green for emergency vehicles while responding to calls. All of our trucks are equipped with the system except one. There are 3 main traffic lights that are in our response area that do not have the system in place (21/21, MCAS, Grays Hill). The county has agreed to do all three lights if we can come up with half the cost, roughly \$8,500. It would also cost about \$3,000 to install the system in the one truck that does not currently have the capability.

So in total this project would cost around \$12,000 of unbudgeted funds.

Commissioner Harris motioned to allow Chief Rountree to have Opticom installed.

Commissioner Peeples seconded.

Motion approved.

Chiefs Report

Engineer Torrey is retiring at the end of this month.

Engineer Beach is no longer with the department.

Lt. Krob is likely going to medically retire. He is starting the process so there is no date set at this time.
