Pinewood Renovations – Palmetto State Bank now has everything they needed from us, so we should receive the loan documents soon. Chief Rountree received the contract from Fraser this week and is currently reviewing it.

PEBA – We received official notice today that we are approved for the state health insurance benefits. Now we are just waiting on them to contact us to discuss enrollment and effective date.

New Business

Propane – Currently there are propane tanks sitting on the lawns at each station. We are in the process of changing propane companies. Palmetto Gas will be the new supplier once our current tanks are empty.

Sirens – Beaufort County is installing sirens throughout the county. They approached us to house one at the Shell Point station. They will be putting up the pole and will not require anything from us other than the space. The sirens will be solar powered and wireless. Chief Rountree signed a MOU this week.
