


## **Purpose of the Grant Process**

## FY16 Review Process

- Received **26** applications with **4** ongoing commitments.
- Evaluated by a diverse volunteer panel of community professionals.
- Applications evaluated on their own merit using a competitive process.



## Highlights from FY15

- Supported local volunteer medical clinics to provide 4,000 needy citizens with medical assistance.
- Over 300 child and adult abuse survivors received counseling and support services.
- 2,764 referrals made to Beaufort County human service agencies for coordinated care.
