#### FY 2018-2019 Budget Priorities - Expenditures

#### Mandatory Budget Expenditures

- 1. 1% Increase in Employer Contributions to SC Retirement System \$600,000
- 2. Solid Waste Hauling and Disposal Costs \$400,000

#### Highly Recommended Budget Expenditure

1. Step/Merit Increases for County Employees - \$1,000,000



#### FY 2018-2019 Budget Priorities - Expenditures

Interim Administrator Budget Recommendations:

- A. Support for Economic Development Initiatives
- 1. Internal County Support for Business Retention and Expansion Purposes by 50% reduction of Business License Tax \$850,000
- 2. External Support for Attracting New Business Relocation to Beaufort County \$500,000/year reflected as .25mils on tax bill to capture future growth in mil value.
- B. Funding for Beaufort Memorial Hospital \$550,000 reflected as dedicated mil value on tax bill.

#### FY 2017-2018 Budget Priorities – Revenues

- Increased Collections due to TIF Terminations

Value: \$750,000

- Increased property tax revenue by approximately 2.5%

Value: \$2,500,000

- Reallocation of Internal Cost Differentials

Value: \$1,500,000

- Increased Investment Income

Value: \$400,000

- HHI Sheriff Expenses Reimbursement Request

Value: \$250,000

- Increased Collection of Fees for Services

Value: \$100,000

Additional Revenue - \$5,500,000

Proposed FY19 budget = 0 mil Increase (Reflected on Tax Bill as 49.49 County Ops and New .27 Economic Development Line Item, and .35 Beaufort Memorial Hospital and .50 Beaufort, Jasper, Hampton Comprehensive Health Services Indigent Healthcare Line Items)

Projected FY18 mil value 2.5% increase = \$1,864,679
