BACKGROUND. Construction of the new ARFF Station at the Hilton Head Island Airport is approximately 60% complete. Since starting this project some construction change order items have been identified. These additional cost items are the result of FAA, County, and Town of Hilton Head building requirements not included in the project plans and specifications. A list of the items is attached for your information. The construction management team has reviewed these costs and determined them to be reasonable. The single most expensive item, flood panels, are needed in order to ensure that the facility can withstand a Category 3 storm event. The total amount of the construction change order is \$118,223.00.

FUNDING. The FAA has agreed to cover 95% of the cost of this change order under their existing grant offer for this project. Since the State does not routinely modify their grant offers, the remaining 5%, which amounts to \$5,911.00, will come from the Airports Account #13580-59040 which has a current balance of \$17,834.00.

RECOMMENDATION. That the Public Facilities Committee approve and recommend to County Council approval of a construction change order in the amount of \$118,223.00 to Creative Structures for the new Aircraft Rescue & Fire Fighting Station at the Hilton Head Island Airport.

BACKGROUND. In August 2010, Beaufort County issued a Request for Qualifications/Proposals from firms to provide construction management and construction engineering and inspection services for the above reference project as part of the 1% Sales Tax for roads for Beaufort County. This project will be funded by the Beaufort County 1% Sales Tax Program Funds Acct #33401-54500 for Sales Tax Project #1 – Bluffton Parkway Phase 5.

The following 6 consultant firms responded and provided proposals for the project on September 8, 2010:

A selection committee consisting of the Beaufort County Director of Engineering & Infrastructure, Beaufort County Engineer, Beaufort County Purchasing Director, and Beaufort County Engineering Construction Manager was assembled to review the proposals, evaluate and rank the proposals using established criteria on the basis of the "best experience and value offered" rather than solely on the lowest price. As a result, three consultant firms – Thomas & Hutton Engineering Company, Florence and Hutchinson, Inc., and Coleman Snow Consultants, LLC were chosen for the interviews. Based on their extensive project experience with other parkway phases, understanding of local conditions, an innovative project reporting methodology, and associated fee, the selection committee recommends that Thomas & Hutton Engineering Company offers the overall best qualification and value for the proposed services.

RECOMMENDATION. That the Public Facilities Committee approve and recommend to County Council approval of an award to Thomas & Hutton Engineering Company for Bluffton Parkway 5A Roadwork Construction Management (CM) and Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) Services in the amount of \$1,014,000.00.

Dear Mr. Klink,

We would like to once again thank the County for the opportunity to provide this information and continue the successful partnership we have enjoyed on past projects. We are in receipt of the contractor's preliminary schedule for the construction of Bluffton Parkway Phase 5A. At the County's request we have evaluated our CEI personnel needs for the project based on the preliminary schedule and updated our estimate accordingly. Attached to this letter is our updated staffing schedule and updated cost estimate for the project.

The attached construction staffing chart is based on the information provided by the contractor on how he plans to construct the project. As you will notice, the majority of the work by the contractor is expected to occur between April and August 2011. With the concentration of work during these months the need for multiple inspectors on the job will increase as the workload increases. As discussed previously, we will not assign any additional inspectors to the project than what will actually be needed based on the contractors activities. This flexibility in staffing will allow us to save the County money.

Attached to this letter is an updated budget estimate spreadsheet for our anticipated services. The time shown is based on the work times shown on the attached construction staffing chart. Based on the enclosed schedule provided by the contractor we were able to reduce the time needed for all of the on-call inspectors and in an effort to increase our flexibility we added some additional time for HSA to complete some inspection on the project. The overall project savings for CEI based on the Contractor's schedule is approximately \$63,000.00. Our field office at HSA's office in Sheridan Park provides us maximum flexibility for staffing the job due to its proximity to the project as well as the proximity of our on-call inspectors to the project. After reviewing the schedule provided we decided to add the time reduction for the schedule back into the contingency items section in order to provide flexibility for the County during construction as it is likely the contractor's schedule will change as he begins work on the project.

We are continuing to develop and test our online reporting tool and will have it ready for use once the project is ready to begin work. We will be doing some testing with your office in the next week and will notify you on what needs to be done prior to the testing. We are also working with HSA on the office space for the project field office. We are ready to mobilize equipment and prepare the field office for operation as soon as the County issues us the authorization to proceed. The field office and online reporting tool will provide great flexibility to the County and those working on the project and in the end save the County time and money on this phase of work.

We appreciate the opportunity to continue our work with Beaufort County and provide this additional information. If you have any questions regarding the information included in this letter or any of the attachments please contact me at 921-721-4160.

1. Schedule for the project provided by Beaufort County based on initial schedule from Contractor. If the Contractor's schedule changes during the construction of the project then the personnel required and time required may be more or less than what is shown on this spreadsheet and in the attached schedule.
2. Time taken out of the Construction Engineering & Inspection section has been added to the Contingency Items section. We have reviewed the preliminary schedule provided by the contractor and do not feel the project will be constructed as shown in this preliminary schedule. We would recommend the County include the items shown in the Contingency items section in the contract to allow for flexibility during construction created by changes in the schedule during construction. Time has been added to the Sampling & Testing Services section to allow an employee from H S A to be included on the project inspection team. This will allow greater Flexibility in our staffing and not require us to keep personnel on the job in anticipation of the contractor working on a particular task.

BACKGROUND. On September 28, 2010, Engineering Division staff presented an award recommendation for the subject project to Patterson Construction Company, Inc., in the amount of \$44,203.00 to the Public Facilities Committee. On September 29, 2010, Merit Marine Construction, Inc., filed a protest of the award to Patterson Construction Company for the Lands End Public Beach Access Improvements. This bid protest was filed on the basis that Addendum #1 to the Request for Proposals stated that a "SC Marine License (MR) is required for the awarded contractor for this project." Staff intended Addendum #1 statement to convey that the improvements involve water construction activities for which a marine contractor's license is needed. Patterson Construction Company does not hold a marine contractor license classification, but their proposal does provide for a local marine contractor to install pilings to support the new access steps. In most contracting scenarios, a licensed general contractor may bid on work if more than 40% of the work falls within one or more of their license classifications and Patterson Construction Company is licensed to perform carpentry for structural work.

Upon receipt of the Merit Marine Construction protest letter, staff contacted the SC State Contractor's Licensing Board for additional guidance on using a general contractor along with a licensed marine sub-contractor to perform elements of the construction work. The Contractors Licensing Board advised that all of this project's construction work falls under a marine license classification; therefore, a general contractor must have a marine license classification to perform the improvements for the Lands End Public Beach access. The SC Contractor Licensing Board disagrees with the interpretation that a general contractor could perform the carpentry for the steps if the balance of work (water activities) was sub-contracted to a marine contractor.

Since Patterson Construction Company does not hold a marine classification, the prior recommendation for award must be withdrawn and an alternate recommendation issued for the committee's consideration. No contracts have been issued to Patterson Construction Company at this time.

RECOMMENDATION. That the Public Facilities Committee cancel the contract award to Patterson Construction Company, Inc., to design and build the Lands End Public Beach Access Improvements in the amount of \$44,203.00.

BACKGROUND. Beaufort County currently has four beach accesses along Bay Point Road in the Land's End area on St. Helena Island, SC. There are only two existing stairways on site and they are both in bad shape and too narrow to meet any code requirements. In order to provide the public better, easier and safer usage to the Beaufort River beach front at Lands End, Beaufort County Public Works requested that the Engineering Division issue a Request for Proposal to design and build four new beach accesses. This including the construction of one, new 5- foot wide access stairway; replacement of two existing stairways with new 5 - foot wide stairways; and the construction of one new ADA compliant walk way at the end of Bay Point Road.

A Request for Proposals for qualified design-build firms was issued in June 2010. The design-build proposal process differs from a typical construction bid in that the proposers submit concept drawings and outline how they will accomplish the project within a specified cost. The following four firms responded and provided proposals on August, 5 2010:

A selection committee consisting of the Assistant County Engineer, Construction Manager, Facility's Management Director, Deputy Director for Facility's Management and Public Work General Support Superintendent was assembled to review, evaluate and rank the proposals. This is a design build project and each proposer submitted their proposal based on their understanding of the work to be provided. Accordingly, each proposal was reviewed based on established criteria, including the proposers approach to work to be performed, and the proposals were ranked based on the "best value offered" rather than solely on the lowest price. Patterson Construction, Inc. was initially selected as the proposer providing the best value for this project but an award was subsequently protested and canceled. On that basis, the committee recommends the next highest rated firm O'Quinn Marine Construction, Inc. to provide these services. O'Quinn Marine Construction 's proposal also complies with the County's Small and Minority Business ordinance.

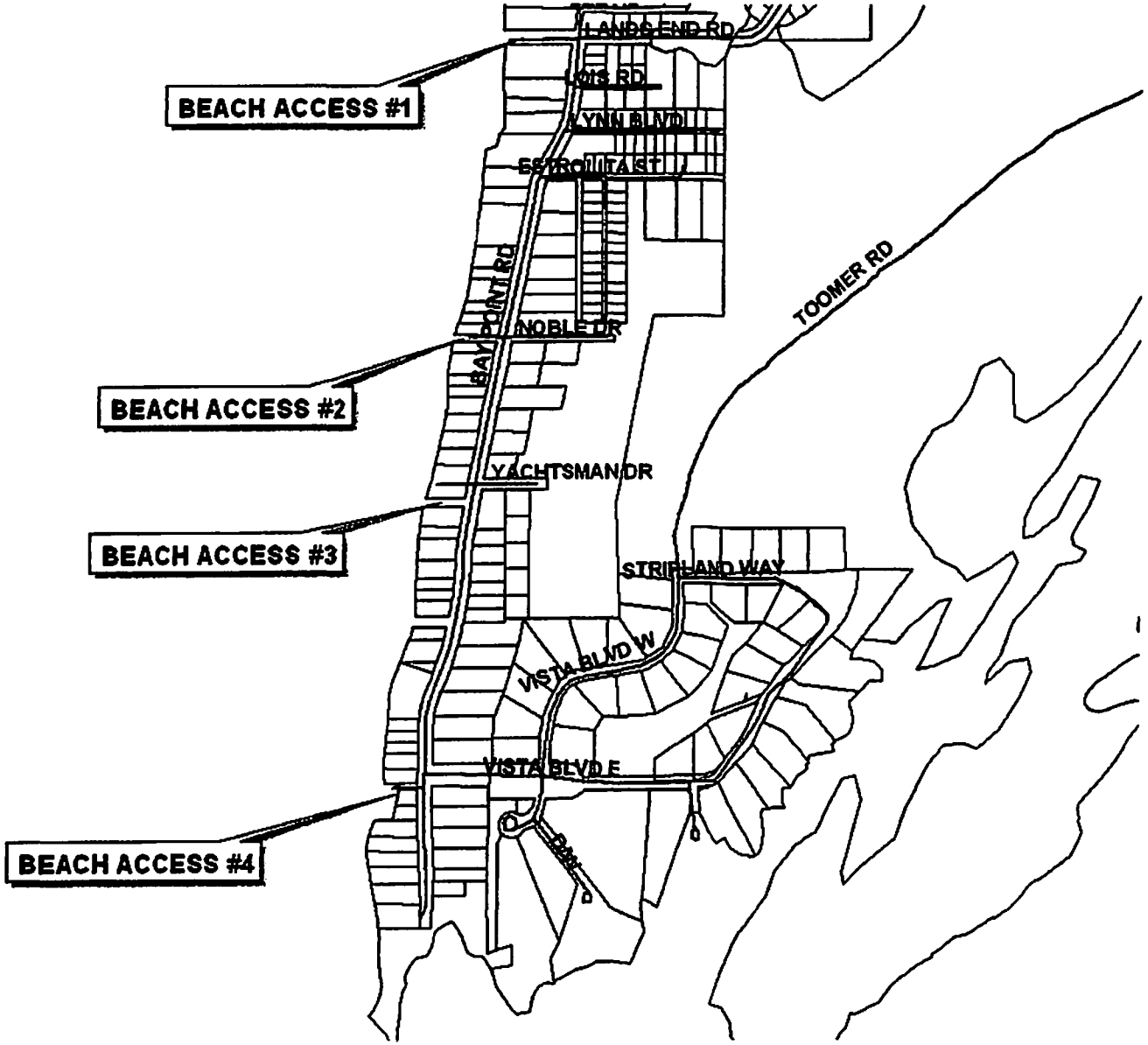
Lands End Public Beach Access Improvements project will be funded by Lands End Public Access CIP Account #11435-54433, with current balance of \$75,546.00.

RECOMMENDATION. That the Public Facilities Committee approves a contract award to O'Quinn Construction, Inc. to design and build the Lands End Public Beach Access Improvements in the amount of \$58,525.00 along with funding as proposed above.
