

# **Minority Businesses**

Beaufort County actively encourages small and minority subcontractor participation in all Beaufort County contracts. Attention of the bidders is called to contract conditions contained herein pertaining to nondiscrimination, equal employment opportunity, and subcontracting opportunities.

It is the policy of Beaufort County that small and minority owned business enterprises be given fair opportunity to participate as sources of needed supplies, construction, and other services whenever possible. Bid documents require documentation of a bidder's efforts to recruit small and minority business.

In order to demonstrate compliance, bidders shall submit the following completed documents with the sealed bid submittal clearly marked with the bid number, project name and number and marked "Small and Minority Business Program Participation" with their bid:

Signed Non-discrimination statement

Proposed schedule of small and minority owned business enterprise participation and;

Documentation of Bidder's Recruiting Effort (10 day notice to subcontractors).

# Local Preference

A competitive procurement made by the county shall be made from responsive and responsible resident vendors in the county for procurement, if such bid does not exceed the lowest qualified bid from a nonlocal vendor by more than five percent or \$10,000.00 whichever is less of the lowest nonlocal bidder. The local vendor has the discretion to match the bid submitted by the nonlocal vendor and receive the contract award.

A vendor shall be deemed to be a "local vendor" if such vendor is an individual, partnership, association or corporation that is authorized to transact business within the state, maintains an office in Beaufort County, has a business license of Beaufort County or one of the municipalities within Beaufort County, and maintains a representative inventory of commodities within Beaufort County or one of the municipalities on which the bid is submitted and has paid all taxes duly assessed.

If no bids are received from a Beaufort County Local Vendor, a vendor shall be deemed to be a "local vendor" if such vendor is an individual, partnership, association or corporation that is authorized to transact business within the state, maintains an office in Jasper, Hampton, and Colleton Counties (local preference only applies if Jasper, Hampton and Colleton Counties offer reciprocity to Beaufort County). A competitive procurement made by the county shall be made from responsive and responsible resident vendors in the respective counties for procurement, if such bid does not exceed the lowest qualified bid from a nonlocal vendor by more than five percent or \$10,000.00, whichever is less, local vendor has the discretion to match the bid submitted by the nonlocal vendor and receive the contract award.



# How Does the Bidding Process Work?

# **Purchasing Thresholds**

# Purchases in Amounts of \$0-\$2500

Beaufort County Departments may obtain a single quote from the vendor of their choice. These purchases may be made by period or Net 30 invoicing. However price must be fair and reasonable.

# Purchases in Amounts of \$501-\$2,500

Beaufort County Departments may obtain a single quote from the vendor of their choice. These purchases may be made by peard or Purchase Order. However price must be fair and reasonable.

# Purchases in Amounts of \$2,500— \$10,000

Beaufort County Departments must obtain three formal (written) quotes from three different vendors. These purchases may be made by Purchase Order. The lowest responsive, responsible bidder will be selected.

# Purchases in Amounts of \$10,001—25,000.

Purchases are subject to the requirements of the competitive bidding process unless specifically exempted by state law. These purchases are made by Purchase Order All purchases over \$10,001 must be approved by the County Administrator

# Purchases in Amounts of \$25,001—49,999

Purchases are subject to the requirements of the competitive bidding process unless specifically exempted by state law. Cont. These purchases are made by Purchase Order. Must be approved by Council Committee.

# Purchases \$50,000 and over

Purchases are subject to the requirements of the competitive bidding process unless specifically exempted by state law. These purchases are made by Purchase Order. Must be approved by County Council.

# **Bidding Methods**

Beaufort County utilizes competitive bidding for the contracting of goods and services over \$10,000 unless exempted by state and county law. We make every effort to continually seek sources that have the capability to meet the needs of the County at competitive prices.

# **Public Advertising**

Purchases and contracts involving the expenditure of more than \$10,001 require public notice of the time and place where sealed bids or proposals will be received. All public notices will be advertised in the Beaufort Gazette, Island Packet, The South Carolina Business Opportunities Newsletter, and the County's website www.begov.net. Invitation for Bids

Unless exempted by law, county purchases of goods and services exceeding \$10,001 must be solicited under the sealed bid process. This process shall include the advertisement of bids, receipt of sealed bids in accordance with plans and specifications, public opening of bids and award to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder by Beaufort County Council.

# Requests for Proposal

A written or published solicitation issued by an authorized procurement official for proposals to provide supplies, services information technology or construction which ordinarily result in the award of the contract to the responsible bidder making the proposal determined to be most advantageous to Beaufort County. The award of the contract must be made on the basis of evaluation.

# Request for Qualifications

Before soliciting bids the procurement officer may issue a request for qualifications from prospective bidders. The request must contain, at a minimum, a description of the scope of work to be solicited by the invitation for bids, the deadline for submission of information, and how prospective bidders may apply for consideration. The request must require information concerning prospective bidders and the product specifications, qualifications, experience, and ability to perform the requirements of the contract. Adequate public notice of the request for qualifications must be given. After receipt of the responses to the request for qualifications from prospective bidders, the rank of the prospective bidders must be determined in writing from most qualified to least qualified on the basis of the information provided. The Purchasing Director shall negotiate a contract with the firm considered to be the most qualified.

# Bid Security

Bid Security, in the form of a cashier's check, certified check or bid bond is mandatory for bid submission for all construction bids of \$30,000 or greater in value\*. Although usually five percent of the bid value, the amount of the security may vary depending on the specifics of the bid.

\*Bid Security may be required on nonconstruction projects. Please refer to bid documents for more info.





### INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this guide is to make available to vendors basic information for obtaining and participating in the purchasing processes of Beaufort County, South Carolina. The Purchasing Department serves as the County's central procurement office for processing the County's goods and services; and its mission is to maximize the value of public funds in procurements, by contracting and management of efficient services, capital equipment, and material investments, while upholding tenets of integrity, responsiveness, and fairness to both internal and external customers.

### ABOUT BEAUFORT COUNTY

Beaufort (pronounced bu-FERT) County is one of South Carolina's fastest growing counties and is nationally recognized for its historic downtown, expansive waterway views, and lush landscapes. The County sits along the Atlantic Ocean and is comprised of hundreds of barrier and sea islands; its warm climate, pristine beaches, world-class golf, great boating, dining and shopping options, historic sites, Gullah traditions, and Southern hospitality make it a

top place to live, work, and play.


The area is rich with history, culture, and natural beauty, and has seen significant growth in the past few decades. The County's population grew 63% from 86,425 to 137,849 between 1990 and 2005; and according to the 2010 U.S. Census, the population has grown an additional 13% to 155,215.

The Winter 2008 edition of Southern Business and Development magazine listed Beaufort County as the number one "great small town to operate a business":

"Beaufort County, with the historic waterfront town of Beaufort, the unique resort community Hilton Head Island, the lively port town of Port Royal, and techsavy Bluffton, is one of the hottest spots in the South for both business development and retirement. [Why is it a great small town to operate a business?] Located midway between Savannah, Georgia and Charleston, South Carolina, maybe it's the infrastructure the region has to get businesses up and running. ### **BUSINESS LICENSING**

Beaufort County requires any business operating within its unincorporated boundaries to obtain a Beaufort County Business License. Applications for new business licenses may be obtained online at <a href="https://www.bcgov.net">www.bcgov.net</a> – Look under the "About" tab, then see "Departments", "Public Service", and "Business License". Applications may be mailed to the Beaufort County Business License Department at Post Office Drawer 1228, Beaufort, SC 29901, or hand-delivered to one of two Business License Office locations. # ABOUT THE PURCHASING DEPARTMENT

As the County's main procurement office, the Purchasing Department seeks to provide fair and equitable treatment of all involved in purchasing by the County, to maximize the value of public funds in procurement, and to maintain a procurement system of quality and integrity.

### PROCUREMENT CODE

The SC Consolidated Procurement Code requires the County to have a procurement code that is substantially similar. The County has developed such a code that governs the expenditure of all funds regardless of source; details of the code may be found within the Beaufort County Code of Ordinances, accessible online at <a href="https://www.bcgov.net">www.bcgov.net</a> under the tab "Online Services". The Purchasing Department adheres to and abides by this code.

### **BIDDING METHODS**

Beaufort County uses competitive bidding to contract goods and services over \$25,000 unless exempted by law. The Purchasing Department makes every effort to continually seek sources that have the capability to meet the needs of the County at competitive prices.

### Public Advertising

Purchases and contracts involving the expenditure of more than \$25,000 require public notice of time and place where sealed bids or proposals will be received. All public notices will be advertised on the County's website at <a href="https://www.bcgov.net">www.bcgov.net</a> and in local newspapers, as well as the South Carolina Business Opportunities Newsletter (<a href="https://www.mmo.sc.gov">www.mmo.sc.gov</a>).

### Invitation for Bids

Unless exempted by law, County purchases of goods and services exceeding \$25,000 must be solicited under the sealed bid process. This process shall include the advertisement of bids, receipt of sealed bids in accordance with plans and specifications, public opening of bids, and award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

# Requests for Proposals (RFP)

A written or published solicitation for proposals to provide supplies or services which ordinarily result in the award of the contract to the responsible bidder making the proposal determined to be most advantageous to the County. The award of the contract must be made on the basis of evaluation criteria.

# Request for Qualifications (RFQ)

Before soliciting bids, the County may issue a RFQ to prospective bidders which must contain, at a minimum, a description of the scope of work to be solicited, the deadline for submission of information, and how prospective bidders may apply for

consideration. The request must require information concerning prospective bidders and the product specifications, qualifications, experience, and ability to perform the requirements of the contract.

Adequate public notice of both the RFP and RFQ must be given. After receipt of responses and evaluation by a committee, the rank of the respondents must be determined in writing, from the most to the least qualified, on the basis of the information provided. The Purchasing Director shall negotiate a contract with the respondent considered to be the most qualified.

### **BID SECURITY**

Bid Security, in the form of a cashier's check, certified check, or bid bond is mandatory for bid submission for all construction bids of \$30,000 or greater in value.\* Although the bid security is usually five percent (5%) of the bid value, the amount of the security may vary depending on the specifics of the bid documents.

\* May be required on non-construction projects.

# **PURCHASING THRESHOLDS**

### Under \$500:

May be paid via Request for Payment (check) or p-card.

### \$500 - \$2,500:

May be paid via p-card. If a p-card payment is not used a purchase order must be in place. No quotes are required as long as price is "fair and reasonable". May be approved by Purchasing Director or his designee.

# \$2,501-\$5,000:

A purchase order is required. Two written or verbal quotes are required. May be approved by Purchasing Director or his designee.

### \$5,001-\$10,000:

A purchase order is required. Three written quotes are required. Must be approved by Purchasing Director and CFO or their designees.

# \$10,001 - \$25,000:

A purchase order is required. Three written quotes are required. Must be approved by Purchasing Director, CFO, Deputy County Administrator, and County Administrator or their designees.

### \$25,001-\$50,000:

A formal solicitation is required if a prior solicited contract is not available. Requires approval by County Committee.

### \$50,001 and up:

A formal solicitation is required if a prior solicited contract is not available. Requires approval by County Council.

### LOCAL VENDOR PREFERENCE

A competitive procurement shall be made by the County from responsive and responsible local (resident) vendors in Beaufort County for procurement, if such bid does not exceed the lowest qualified bid from a non-local vendor by more than five percent (5%) or \$10,000, whichever is less of the lowest non-local bidder. The local vendor has the discretion to match the bid submitted by the non-local vendor and receive the contract award. A vendor shall be deemed to be a "local vendor", if such vendor is an individual, partnership, association, or corporation that is authorized to transact business within the state of South Carolina, maintains an office in Beaufort County, and maintains a representative inventory of commodities within Beaufort County and has paid all taxes duly assessed.

### SMALL AND MINORITY BUSINESS PROGRAM

Beaufort County recognizes that the South Carolina General Assembly, in South Carolina Code of Laws Section 11-35-5210, has declared that businesses owned and operated by minority persons have been historically restricted from full participation in our free enterprise system to a degree disproportionate to other businesses; and that it is in the state's best interest to assist minority-owned businesses to develop fully as a part of the state's policies and programs which are designed to promote balanced economic and community growth throughout the state. Beaufort County wishes to ensure that those businesses owned and operated by minorities are afforded the opportunity to fully participate in its overall procurement process for goods and services. Further, Beaufort County seeks to ensure that small businesses are likewise afforded the same opportunity as minority businesses to participate. Based on scope of work or services, solicitations may require bidders or proposers to meet certain compliance requirements of Beaufort County's "Small and Minority Business Participation Program", unless self-performing one hundred percent (100%), including specific pre-award good faith outreach efforts and post-award subcontracting reporting. regarding this program can be e-mailed to: compliance@bcgov.net .

# CONTACT WITH COUNTY OFFICIALS AND STAFF

Communication between vendors and potential users in County departments is acceptable on such subject matter as, availability of specified requirements, technical information, instructional information, requests for literature, etc., unless otherwise instructed in a solicitation notice issued by the County. <u>BACKGROUND</u>. Burton Wells Regional Park is a 313 acre park located at 1 Middleton Recreation Drive. Phase I, completed in 2004, is composed of active facilities which include racquetball courts, a fitness room, a basketball court, activity rooms, soccer, football and baseball fields. In January 2009, a 2,200-sqft Senior Center was constructed adjacent to the main facility.

In FY07, County Council approved CIP funding for Phase II "passive" improvements to the park.

Review of the REA bid indicated that they altered the original bid form, rendering their bid non-responsive\*. Both bidders were found to have irregularities in their County SMBE documentation in that, neither firm met the

ten day notice to potential subcontractors. APAC documented a nine day notice to potential local SMBE firms and intends to utilize two SMBE firms. This solicitation is unique in that both bidders are the only two area SCDOT certified asphalt producers and there is limited potential for subcontracting on a resurfacing project. If this project were to be rebid, there is limited probability of improving local SMBE participation and a re-bid will delay resurfacing without the probability of cost savings. Also, the bid is below the Engineers Estimate and very good/competitive bids.

APAC submitted the lowest qualified bid, and their bid prices were reviewed. The APAC written total bid amount was \$ \$618,124.33 but was determined during certification to be corrected to \$618,124.23, a variance of ten cents (\$0.10). Based on the bid analysis, and over-all good faith effort for local SMBE solicitations, the Engineering Division recommends award of this contract to Oldcastle Southern Group dba APAC Southeast, Inc.



BACKGROUND. Talbert, Bright, and Ellington, Inc. is currently under contract to provide professional consulting and engineering services in support of Beaufort County airport projects. Attached is the proposed scope of work to prepare preliminary tree obstruction survey data regarding the 34:1 slope for Runway 03 at the Hilton Head Island Airport. This preliminary survey will determine the extent of existing obstructions in the 34:1 approach slope. Follow on detailed survey work as well as project plans and specifications will still need to be developed. The Airports Board favorably endorses the tree obstruction removal projects at the airport.

FUNDING. Funding for this project will come from an existing FAA Grant (95%), Account #13480-54293, Remove Obstructions South End Design, which has a current balance of \$97,391.00; an existing State Grant (2.5%); and the local 2.5% match of \$1,071.83 which will come from the Airports Operating Budget.

BACKGROUND. Beaufort County issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals from qualified firms to provide for the collection of scrap metals and white goods from certain designated County convenience centers, removal of Freon as appropriate, and marketing of the material to a processing facility. Proposals from five (5) firms were received (see Attachment 1) and the list was narrowed to two firms by the evaluation committee based on experience, performance capability, and potential revenue generation. The two firms met with the committee on April 20, 2011: (1) Action A1 Demolition, Inc. with offices in Dallas, NC and Clover, SC (2) Charleston Steel & Metal Co. located in Charleston, SC. The committee received presentations from both firms and asked a series of questions to each.

The evaluation committee comprised of the Public Works Director, the Solid Waste Manager, the General Support Superintendent of Public Works, and a representative from the Solid Waste and Recycling Advisory Board evaluated the firm's proposals, presentations and responses to their questions. Oversight of the process was provided by the Purchasing Director and the Compliance Officer. The panel ranked the firm's according to the RFP selection criteria. Charleston Steel and Metal Co. received the highest ranking by the committee, based on a long term history of providing outstanding service over the last nine years to Beaufort County, demonstrated ability to perform the work and a competitive revenue sharing strategy.

FUNDING. Services are paid to the firm through the sale of the scrap metal material. The firm shares proceeds with Beaufort County based on a published market rate specified by the contract minus their service fees. Revenues received will be deposited into account 10001-47440, Sale of Recyclables,

### RECOMMENDATION.

We recommend that the Public Services Committee approve and recommend to County Council the award of the contract to provide scrap metal and white goods services to Charleston Steel and Metal Company, the top ranked firm. The agreement is for an initial three year contract with two one-year renewal options.

BACKGROUND. Beaufort County issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit proposals from qualified firms to provide for the hauling of solid waste from County convenience centers and to provide necessary containers at those centers for waste collection. Proposals from the following three (3) firms were received; Waste Management of South Carolina, Inc. (WM), Republic Waste Services of Hilton Head (Republic), and Waste Pro USA, Inc. (Waste Pro). The evaluation committee comprised of the Public Works Director, the Solid Waste Manager, the General Support Superintendent of Public Works, the Solid Waste Operations Superintendent, a representative from the Solid Waste and Recycling Advisory Board and the Solid Waste Data Analyst evaluated the firm's proposals according to the RFP evaluation criteria. To aid in the evaluation, a spreadsheet was developed to project annual cost based on each firm's proposal. Oversight of the process was provided by the Purchasing Director and the Compliance Officer.

Annual projected cost for each firm was as follows: Waste Pro (\$812,438); Republic (\$910,412); and WM (\$1,003,088). Waste Pro received the highest ranking by the committee, based on strong recommendations by current customers, ability of to perform the work and the lowest projected cost to the County. The firm met with the committee on May 17, 2011. The committee asked a series of questions to the firm to clarify their proposal and a contract agreement was negotiated.

<u>FUNDING.</u> Services are paid to the firm through the budget account 33390-51165, Solid Waste Hauling Services. Sufficient funds are budgeted to cover the annual projected cost of this service.

#### RECOMMENDATION.

We recommend that the Public Services Committee approve and recommend to County Council the award of the contract to provide solid waste hauling services to Waste Pro, Inc., the top ranked firm. The agreement is for an initial three year contract with two one-year renewal options.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>. Bostick Road is a County-owned right-of-way located in Salem Plantation Subdivision. Although shown on numerous plats as a 60' r-o-w, the street itself was never constructed.

A recent survey by David Gasque, RLS, has brought to light an error or omission in the original subdivision surveys that have resulted in a misrepresentation of Bostick Road, the misrepresentation being that the r-o-w is 60' wide. In reality, the r-o-w width varies and is less than 60'.

Bostick Road is situated between Blocks C and D of Salem Plantation Subdivision. These Blocks were surveyed at different times by different surveyors. While each survey labels Bostick Road as a 60' r-o-w, neither surveyor actually surveyed the r-o-w area. In reality, the space between the two blocks, which would correspond to the r-o-w, is less than 60'.

Additional factors contributing to the confusion over r-o-w width are the survey changes applied to Lot 15-C. This is the only lot in Block C adjacent to Bostick Road. The lot was originally surveyed as being 144.71' wide at its widest point. A subsequent survey reduced this figure to 114.7'. A third survey restored the lot to its original width.

As a result of the error(s) outlined above, contemporary surveys of Lots 1-D and 2-D are shown with "Areas of Confusion". These areas reflect the fact that the Bostick Road r-o-w varies in width, much of it being less than 60'. Obviously, any potential purchaser of either lot would have reservations about these "Areas of Confusion". To remedy this situation the owners of Lots 1-D and 2-D, Alan Williams, Melanie Williams and Mildred Simpson, have proposed three alternative solutions:

- 1. The County quitclaim the platted "Areas of Confusion" to the property owners
- 2. The County quitclaim a 10'-wide stripalong the entire length of Bostick Road, thus reducing the County's r-o-w to 50'
- 3. The County quitclaim a 13.38'-wide strip of land along the entire length of Bostick Road, the 13.38' corresponding to the widest point of the "Areas of Confusion"


The County Staff Attorney has recommended Solution #2: that the County quitclaim a 10'-wide strip of land running the entire length of Bostick Road to the owners of Lots 1-D and 2-D.


<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>. That the Public Facilities Committee consider the property owners' request and recommend to County Council that Solution #2 be approved.

After having consulted with county engineers, Eric Klatt and Robert Klink, surveyor David Gasque, and neighbor Mildred Simpson, we are hereby submitting two formal requests to the county in regards to the property that we own at 2 Bostick Road, Salem Plantation Subdivision.

- 1) We hereby petition Beaufort County to formally relinquish claim to the 835 square feet of confusion on the southwest corner of the lot imposed upon our property(Lot 1D) in 2005. Due to the imposition of the 60 foot right of way, at its widest point, this triangle encroaches 13.38 feet into what should rightfully be our deeded land. In attempting to find suitable placement for a home, garage, septic tank, and driveway for a future homesite, it is crucial that this area of confusion be granted. (see accompanying exhibit)
- 2) Since Beaufort County Public Works only requires more or less a 50 foot right of way, we would also hereby petition that the entire right of way be reduced 13.38 feet on its eastern boundary, leaving a 45.81 foot right of way from Plantation Drive to the adjoining Bostick property. At present there are no known plans for paving or any other use for the right of way, and we feel that the surrounding land owners are entitled to benefit from this reduction so that access is still made available to all three properties, no boundaries are in question, homesites may be established more easily, and existing landscaping which includes a majestic 200 year old live oak may remain in tact without fear of demolition.

Thank you for consideration of these requests. We would greatly appreciate being kept informed of the status of this matter as it proceeds through various committee and council proceedings so that we may be present at all hearings.



I hereby submit this letter per discussion at our meeting on 2 November, with Melanie Williams and Mr. Klink also present, regarding a question for review of the current Right of Way that was deeded to Beaufort County in September 2005. Due to recent surveys conducted by neighboring properties and subsequent discoveries, there seems to be a discrepancy between the northern boundary of my property and the measurements of the existing Right of Way along my deeded property, known as Bostick Road. Granting of my petition below is requested in order to maintain/restore my property to its previously deeded and defined boundaries.

### Petition Item 1:

At a minimum, I hereby petition Beaufort County to formally relinquish claim to an area measuring 13.38 ft. at the widest point along the Right of Way named Bostick Drive to Mildred E. Simpson, thus maintaining the northern boundary (between Lot 1D and Lot 2D), at a length of 110.1 ft. The attached exhibit drawn by Gasque and Associates, Inc. on 2 November 2010, delineates the defined area to wit for 2231 Plantation Drive, (Lot 2, Block D, Salem Plantation Subdivision, R100-029-014A-0000) Beaufort, SC, that was deeded to William J. Simpson and Mildred E. Simpson on 16 July 1979 (and subsequently to myself upon my husband's demise in 1980). Also attached is a copy of my original survey.

# Background

The same defined area in question was delineated with a 60 ft. right of way deeded to the County of Beaufort on 27 September 2005, with boundaries which overlap my survey of deeded land. Per conversation with Mr. David Gasque, Gasque and Associates, Inc., who has personally measured the property lines in the area and is aware of the discrepancies, there were two (2) conflicting plats for the subdivision, filed at different timeframes. My property, along with the lot now owned by Leonard and Melanie Williams (2 Bostick Drive, Lot 1D), was included in the first survey of Salem Plantation S/D in 1965 and should have precedence. The subsequent deeding of the Right of Way to Beaufort County in 2005 has imposed a different boundary upon my property and is incorrect. The 2005 action and other recorded revisions on the opposite side of the Right of Way have distorted and pushed the geometry of my boundary point back and forth creating the question of encroachment from the Right of Way onto my lot and the Williams' lot.

The defined area along the unpaved right of way is used only as an access by myself and the owners of the two adjoining lots, 2 Bostick Road and 2229 Plantation Drive. At present, there are no known plans for paving or any other use for the Right of Way other than access to these three properties. Granting this petition would rightly resolve any future question and maintain/restore my property to its original surveyed and deeded boundaries.

# Petition Item 2:

With concurrent action, I also request that the entire Right of Way now owned by the County be decreased to a maximum 45.81 ft. Right of Way along its Eastern boundary with subsequent relinquishment of that property adjacent to my lot to my ownership.

# Background:

It is my understanding that only a 50 ft. Right of Way is the County requirement. There are no permanent structures within this area at present other than a SCE&G pole that has always been in place within the eastern portion of the right of way to provide utility services to all three lots in the area. Additional landscaping and a small brick décor wall that are along the driveway and the curb of the street have always been maintained by myself. Reducing the right of way to the West of my lot to 45.81 ft. with relinquishment of that area (see area marked in red cross-lines) to my ownership would resolve all known discrepancies in this matter.

Thank you for your consideration of this request. I would greatly appreciate being kept informed of the status of this matter as it proceeds through various committee and council proceedings so that I may be present as may be necessary at all hearings.


