RESOLUTION 2015/_____

A RESOLUTION OF BEAUFORT COUNTY COUNCIL BANNING SMOKING TOBACCO PRODUCTS ON THE ROBERT SMALLS CAMPUS

WHEREAS, numerous medical and scientific studies show substantial levels of exposure to secondhand smoke among the United States population, and over the last several decades, the health hazards resulting from exposure to secondhand smoke have been increasingly recognized; and

WHEREAS, prohibiting smoking in the workplace increase public awareness of the negative health effects of smoking, reduces the social acceptability of smoking and reduces harm to children and other nonsmokers; and

WHEREAS, in 1982 Beaufort County codified its Code of Ordinance including Section 38-91 through Sec. 38-98; and

WHEREAS, Beaufort County Code Section 38-92 states that smoking shall be prohibited in any and all county-owned and –operated buildings or facilities, public meetings, and public waiting rooms within the confines of any mode of public transportation in the county or other posted areas; and

WHEREAS, non – smoking areas shall be conspicuously posted in each public room and public supported place as defined in Beaufort county Code Sec. 38-91; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that designation of the Robert Smalls Campus as a smoke – free campus is an appropriate act to protect the health and safety of its citizens and employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED to protect the health and safety of Beaufort County citizens that the Robert Smalls Campus located at 100 Ribaut Road shall be designated a smoke – free campus and posted as such pursuant to Beaufort County Code Sec. 38-93.
