Council Action Summary June 2005

Approved on first reading, by title only, text amendments to the Zoning and Development Standards necessary to bring the ordinance in compliance with the recommendations of the Joint Land Use Study.

Approved on second reading the proposed FY 2005-2006 School District budget at 96.6 mils (77.6 mils for operations and 19 mils for debt service). The dollar amount is \$136,898,148 (\$107,756,242 to be derived from tax collections, \$28,242,706 to be derived from State revenues, \$600,000 to be derived from Federal revenues, and \$300,000 to be derived from local revenues.)

Approved on second reading text amendments to the Beaufort County Zoning and Development Standards Ordinance (ZDSO), Article III, Section 106-432, Effect of Approval (amends section to comply with State Law regarding Vested Rights for Approved Developments).

Approved on second reading text amendments to the Beaufort County Zoning and Development Standards Ordinance (ZDSO), Article V, Section 106-1098, Use Table (adds pet grooming as an allowed use in Rural Zoning Districts).

Appointed Ms. Phylis Giglinto to serve as a member of the Social Services Board.

Authorized the County Administrator and his designee to pursue negotiations and subsequent purchase of 4.89 acres of land situated on SC Highway 802, adjacent to Crystal Lake on Lady's Island, under the terms, conditions, and instructions given to the staff attorney.

Awarded a contract to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Cary, North Carolina, in the amount of \$312,153 to complete the US Highway 21/SC Highway 802 Lady's Island By-Pass Planning Study. The funding source is the Northern Beaufort County Impact Fee Program. The overall project budget is \$3,952,000.

Awarded a contract to Daufuskie Island Properties d/b/a/ Daufuskie Island Resort and Breathe Spa, Hilton Head Island, South Carolina in the amount up to \$131,970 total, reflecting a 5% increase, total to be split between Beaufort County School District in the amount of \$43,470 and Beaufort County in the amount of \$88,500.
