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Approved on second reading an ordinance authorizing the donation of approximately 0.39 acres of County-owned real estate to the Child Abuse Prevention Association (CAPA). Further, the property shall be held by the Child Abuse Prevention Association, its successor and assigns and for so long as the premises are used as a house for abused children. If the premises at any time are not so used or are used for any other purpose or by any other organization, the premises shall revert to Beaufort County.

Approved on second reading an ordinance authorizing the County Administrator to execute a Lease Agreement with the Santa Elena Project Foundation for the Federal Courthouse (1501 Bay Street).
