Good morning. It is my pleasure, on behalf of Beaufort County Council, to welcome you all to Hilton Head Island.

In fact the latest figures show an economic impact of \$1.5 billion in 2008. That means ten-percent of all tourism dollars in the entire state are made right here. Hilton Head sees more than \$893 million in gross sales just on overnight visitors each year. Tourism provides the equivalent of lifting more than \$1,000 from the tax burden of each home on the island through sales, accommodations, hospitality and attractions. The state's overall tax relief from tourism is \$600 per household.

The reason we are doing well this recession year may be partly because Hilton Head Island is a reasonable drive for some northern and Midwestern markets, mostly Ohio, Pennsylvania, New York and Illinois. Although we have a commercial airport on the island – about 76-percent of our visitors arrive by car - and many are people with children who are here for a family vacation. I am proud of Hilton Head Island's fame and international status as a luxury resort destination that offers so much for the entire family and for individuals, yet retains its spectacular, natural outdoor beauty.

The nearly 40,000 people who reside on this island truly believe they live in an American paradise. They are proud to call it home. We certainly appreciate those of you who choose to come this way and share our beautiful island with us. Thank you for selecting Hilton Head Island. Again, welcome to this unique corner of the South Carolina Lowcountry. I extend to each of you my sincere wishes for a productive, memorable and wonderful visit. Thank you.
