6. Old Business.

A. YEAR 4 RESURFACING UPDATE

Ms. Andrea Atherton, Transportation Engineering Director

This contract was awarded to Eurovia Atlantic Coast LLC, dba Blythe for \$1,391,619. Change Order number one has been executed to include Twin Lakes Road, Duke Street, Schwartz Road and Schork Road for an additional \$345,903. There is a pending change order to extend work to repair Big Estate Circle. This portion of the project is to be funded half by C Funds and the other half by TAG funds. They have completed asphalt overlay on Burton Wells and Cherokee Farms. All the mircrosurfacing is complete on Sherrington Plantation Park Dr, Pin Oak Dr, Ninth Ave, Foreman Hill, and Murray Dr. Next up will be Twin Lakes and Old Salem, Schork and Schwartz and if approved Big Estate Circle. Based on the contract amount, 45% of the work is completed. The date of completion for Twin Lakes and Big Estate is anticipated to be June 30, 2021. The overall completion date is anticipated to be October of 2021.

B. YEAR 4 REJUVENATOR UPDATE

This contract was awarded to Pavement Technology Inc. The original contract amount was \$191,777. change order one allotted an additional \$19,011 to include work on Buck Island from Fording island to Buckwalter they completed all work in fourteen days which came down to \$0.94 / SY.

C. DIRT ROAD PAVING CONTRACT #52 UPDATE

This contract was awarded to J.H Hiers as the contractor and Andrews Engineering for the Design. There are four roadways included in this contract. Harrison Island Rd (Okatie), Wright Place (HHI), Wickecliff Place (Beaufort), and David Green Road (St. Helena Island). The roads are listed in the order that they are planning for design and construction. Engineering and surveying for this contract has started. All roads are expected to be completed by August of 2022.

D. PAVEMENT CONDITION SURVEY UPDATE

This contract was awarded to F&ME Consultants, Inc. The last pavement condition survey was conducted in 2017. That established the county's five-year paving program. The county is currently on year four of the program and will bid out for year five again in the fall to be done in the spring and summer. F&ME is to provide the next five-year program developing a fiscally constrained maintenance and preservation program. Anticipated completion is November of 2021.

7. New Business.

A. REORGANIZATION OF THE ENGINEERING DIVISION

In the past year the Engineering Division has had two vacant positions. One being a Project Manager and the other being a Transportation Engineer. Ms. Andrea Atherton, who has been serving as the Capital Projects Director, has been moved into the role of Transportation Engineering Director. Mr. David Wilhelm,

who was previously over Special Projects, has been moved to the Capital Projects Director eliminating the Special Projects Department. The division is still in search of an Assistant Transportation Construction Manager.

B. BIG ESTATE CIRCLE

Over the past few years, members of the community on Big Estate Circle have reached out to the County Transportation Committee for guidance on how to have this road included on one of the upcoming pavement projects. Unfortunately, Big Estate Circle is maintained by SCDOT and is not directly incorporated in the CTC Network for road improvement. Big Estate Circle is in District 1 and is roughly two miles long. This road has an ADT of less than 500. Mr. Fralix, Elizabeth Penn-Sanders, and Chairman Gordon met to discuss other possible funding sources to start work on Big Estate Circle and were unsuccessful. After a meeting with Blythe, the contractor on Year 4 Resurfacing, the contractor has agreed to proceed with work on Booker T. Washington and include resurfacing of the delaminated areas on Big Estate Circle. To proceed with this work there is a need of \$80,000. The County Transportation Committee must spend \$275,000 by July 1, 2021; \$40,000.00 of this will be committed to the Big Estate Circle project. The other half of the project will be covered by TAG Funds. It was moved by Mr. Backer seconded by Mr. Hill that committee approve the expenditure of \$40,000.00 for the repairs to be made on Big Estate Circle. C. SECONDARY ROAD REVIEW & ASSIGNMENTS

Mr. Gordon and Ms. Penn-Sanders have worked together to create a set of maps of routes that are expected to have work done in year 2021. Along with routes projected to be on the list of state secondaries for years 2022 and 2023. These roads to be reviewed and selected by the committee and to later create a paving program. The implementation of this system allows the committee to cut costs on contractor mobilization and allows them to have a hands-on approach.

D. STATE SECONDARY FUNDING

There is \$280,000 that is required for state secondaries. \$40,000.00 of that total will be designated to Big Estate Circle resurfacing. The other \$240,000.00 will be designated to Island Causeway. 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E. US 170 UPDATE

In 2019, the LATS Committee finalized a corridor access management study on US 170 from US 278 to SC 462. From that study there were three separate projects created, short term, mid-term, and long term. There are 8 segments in the short-term solutions, one of which that has been accomplished by the Beaufort County Transportation Committee and Jasper County Transportation Committee by installing a signal at intersection SC 462 and US 170. That leaves several projects to be completed with a total of roughly three million dollars. The council has commissioned staff to go forward with the design and permitting for the remaining projects in the short-term plan and they are currently facilitating methods to get that work under procurement. Mr. Gordon has met with Jasper County Administrator and has requested that Jasper county contribute roughly one million dollars this project. The committee is pending on state funding for this project for the near future.

F. SCDOT 2021 FINANCIAL FORECAST

The forecast provided from the C Fund Program Manager reflects 1.24 Million Dollars. Of that 1.24 Million, 33% is from donor funds that do not have to be expended on state routes. The committee will spend around \$825,000 of the funds on state routes.
