Good Afternoon Committee Members,

Please find attached a memo from Andrea Atherton concerning our contract with APAC for our year 5 resurfacing program and our required funding for the State Road network.

There are 2 things going on with this update:

First item is CMRB. I'm not sure if you have been following construction material costs, but they have been increasing in price and decreasing in availability; cement/concrete included. Therefore, APAC suggested replacing with full depth path, variable milling and HMA overlay. This alternative has been approved by our engineer and the state so we would like to elect to accept the credit of (\$90,000) in their contract.

Secondly, we have historically used a 10% contingency for full depth repairs on our contracts. As we are on year 5 of our program, we are currently working on the roads with the worst condition. After review by APAC and staff, they found that more areas needed repairs than was allowed in the contingency. The increase needed is \$153,000

So, in summation, at our May meeting we will be voting to increase APAC's contract by \$63,000. The final amount will be based on actual field measurements.

It would have been my preference to vote on this by responding to this email. However, as I suspected, this is not allowed by rules and procedures. We have more than adequate funds to cover this increase and it will have no effect on any future plans. If anyone has concerns, please express them to me or Andrea by close of business on Friday so that we can gage any concerns and not hold up the contract from proceeding. Thank you.
