- 1. CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Murphy called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm

Ms. Dolbey advised that Councilman-elect Passiment assisted with tarp distribution at Hilton Head DOC. - **b. 2019 Palmetto Pride Grant Applications Submitted:** Ms. Carter reported that 2019 Applications have been submitted. Anticipate award notification December 1, 2018
- c. Fall Clean-Up Day November 1: Mr. Horne reported that the event was a huge success. Thanks to all sponsors. Initial data = 1,000 bags (20,000 pounds of litter) were removed. Mr. Wilhelm indicated a Spring and Fall clean-up for 2019 is the goal...hope for council approval
- 7. PUBLIC COMMENT: There was no public comment
- **8. BOARD REQUESTS:** There were no Board requests. Mr. Wilhelm updated members on pending developments per Detention Center operations and a possible Education Officer to handle change. BCSO representative offered an update report at next meeting of new litter laws and impact on officers that are working environmental cases.
