Beaufort County Library BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING Minutes – September 10, 2025– 4:00 p.m. Beaufort Branch Library 311 Scott Street Beaufort, SC 29901

The fifth scheduled meeting for 2025 was held in-person at the Beaufort Branch Library.

I. Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:01pm. A quorum was established.

II. Pledge of Allegiance: Ms. Miller led those in attendance in the Pledge of Allegiance.

III. Public Comment: None.

IV. Introduction of Guests. Ms. Miller greeted guests in attendance.

V. Minutes from meeting held July 16, 2025:

• Mrs. Miller noted the minutes for July 16, 2025 had been previously distributed to all members. There was a unanimous vote to approve without correction.

VI. Correspondence/Memberships: None.

VII. Library Director's Report: Amanda Dickman, Library Director presented her report:

- A. Personnel Update: The Library Organizational Chart is provided for reference. Ms. Dickman noted that since the last board meeting, Library Assistant (PT) at Port Royal is in the process of being filled. There are currently three vacant positions: Senior Librarian at HHI, Collection Development Librarian and Deputy Director.
- **<u>B. Projects Update:</u>** Ms. Dickman reported on library operations, framed within the priorities of the Library's Strategic Plan.
- <u>Strategic Plan Goal: Communication</u> Ms. Dickman reported that the Library's "Tell Your Library Story" video testimonials from cardholders are now available online. She also noted

ongoing communication initiatives, including the Website Redesign and the establishment of a Signage Team with representatives from each branch to support the enhancement of library signage systemwide. Ms. Dickman introduced Traci Cox and explained her role in Library Administration

- Strategic Plan Goal: User Experience Ms. Dickman introduced Theresa Furbish, Programs and Events Librarian, and her role within Library Administration and invited her to share a recap of this year's Summer Reading program. Ms. Dickman announced upcoming projects underway as Artist in Residence with Eveles Church, America 250 planning team, October Staff Development Day to be held at FOODseum at the Culinary Institute of the Technical College of the Lowcountry, Local Author Festival "Pen and Palmetto" (Spring 2026), and the return of Winter Reading for January 2026.
- Strategic Plan Goal: Space: Ms. Dickman announced the installation of new exterior signage at the Beaufort Branch Library and the replacement of carpet in the hallway and Large Meeting Room at the Hilton Head Island Branch. She reported that the Library has submitted an Impact Grant request to the State Library for funding sound-absorption study pods at the Beaufort and Bluffton locations. Ms. Dickman also introduced Leigh Ramey, User Experience Librarian, who joined the Library on July 28. In her first month, Ms. Ramey assisted with drafting the Impact Grant and began transitioning into her new role within Library Administration.
- Strategic Plan Goal: Collections Ms. Dickman announced that two libraries, Saluda and Greenwood, have joined the SCLENDS consortium. She also introduced Darlene Simmons, Technical Services Manager, and Ileana Herrick, Senior Administrative Assistant, and outlined their roles in Library Administration related to financial reporting and library collections.

IX. Committee Reports

<u>A. Finance Committee:</u> Mr. Bogacz communicated the following financial documents in detail and stated that the Beaufort County Library is in good financial standing.

- Beaufort County Library System Budget Update FY 2026: (see attachment)
 - Mr. Bogacz noted that for FY2026, Beaufort County Library received its first State Aid payment of \$257,608. The total State Aid allocation for Beaufort County for FY26 is \$515,216 an increase of \$46,488 from the previous year.
 - Mr. Bogacz explained the documents in detail noting that at 2 months of 17% of the year, the Library has spent 11% of the annual budget for FY26.
- FY 2026 Special Funds Report: (see attachment)
 Mr. Bogacz explained the attached report noting the receipts and expenditures from special fund sources.
- FY 2026 Library Materials Expenditure year-to-date: (for more details, see attachment) Mr. Bogacz explained the document in detail noting that in the first two months of the fiscal year, the Library has spent \$64,364 on library materials.
- FY 2026 South Carolina State Aid document: Ms. Dickman noted the requirement to submit the Collection Development Funding Certification #2 to the State Library in order to receive the second State Aid payment.

- **B. Policies and Procedures Committee**: Ms. Mutterer reported that the committee will schedule a meeting to review the Collection Development and Request for Reconsideration policy.
 - C. Strategic Planning Committee: Ms. Cooper reported that Beaufort County Library received a \$2,500 Planning Grant from the South Carolina State Library to help cover consultant costs for updating the Library's Strategic Plan. She noted that the committee would meet immediately following the board meeting to discuss initial steps to start the process of updating the Library's Strategic Plan.

D. Request for Reconsideration Committee: None.

E. Library Facilities Committee: Ms. Kulpa referred to the facility enhancements detailed in the Director's Report.

F. Liaisons

Friends of the Library (FOL):

- Friends of Beaufort Library: Ms. Dickman noted the next meeting will be September 11th at the Beaufort Branch Library.
- Friends of Bluffton Library: No update.
- Friends of Hilton Head Library: Ms. Miller announced the next meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 16th. She also highlighted the success of a recent Mah Jong program hosted at the Hilton Head Island Branch Library.

<u>Public Library Foundation</u>: Ms. Miller reported that the Foundation will meet virtually on September 17th.

X. Old Business: None.

XI. New Business: Ms. Miller presented the proposal from Mr. David Lauderdale for renaming the South Carolina Room at HHI Library to honor their contributions in supporting the establishment of a library on Hilton Head.

Motion: Ms. Cooper made a motion to rename the South Carolina Room at the Hilton Head Library in honor of John Jakes and Jonathan Daniels. Ms. Robinson provided the second.

Discussion:

- Mr. Bogacz noted that the current room designation as appropriately reflects the collection it houses and suggested considering alternative ways to honor Mr. Jakes and Mr. Daniels.
- Ms. Mutterer asked whether the Library has a policy with objective criteria for evaluating such requests. Ms. Miller referred to the Donations and Gifts Policy, noting the section that addresses this topic.

Action: The motion failed by a vote of 3–5.

Motion: Dr. Porter made a motion to explore recognizing the contributions of John Jakes and Jonathan Daniels. Mr. Bogacz provided the second.

Action: The motion passed unanimously.

XII. Executive Session: Ms. Miller called the board into executive session at 5:00pm.

With a motion from Ms. Mutterer and a second from Mr. Bogacz, Ms. Miller adjourned the executive session at 5:30pm on to reconvene the regular meeting.

Matters arising out of Executive Session:

Ms. Mutterer made a motion to approve the Annual Performance Evaluation of the Library Director. Ms. Kulpa seconded. There was unanimous approval.

XIII. Announcements:

• The next public meeting of the Library Board of Trustees is scheduled for November 12, 2025 at 4pm at the Bluffton Branch Library.

With no other business to discuss, Ms. Miller adjourned the Library Board of Trustees meeting on a motion from Ms. Robinson and a second from Ms. Cooper.
