ABLE Foundation Receives Inaugural Donation from Beaufort Chapter of 100 Women Who Care

ABLE, the Disabilities Foundation of Beaufort County, received a donation of \$12,300 at its board meeting yesterday from the Beaufort Chapter of 100 Women Who Care, a group that meets quarterly and is dedicated to assisting nonprofit organizations which serve the local community. According to Jeneane Ryan, a founding member, the chapter held its first meeting last month and selected ABLE by secret ballot for its inaugural donation, after nominations and short presentations by local non-profits.

Grace Dennis, a Beaufort County Disabilities and Special Needs Board Member, nominated ABLE. The mission of ABLE is to foster and support the activities and purposes of organizations serving people with developmental disabilities. ABLE plans to use the donation to help fund Camp Treasure Chest, a summer camp for children in Beaufort County with special needs.
