Belfair Median Beautification Event

The Southern Beaufort County Corridor Beautification Board, along with Belfair Plantation, will jointly present a newly landscaped stretch of median along U.S. Highway 278 in Bluffton on Friday, May 15, 2015 at 10 a.m.

"The Board is working to enhance the natural beauty of this area. By landscaping the medians in southern Beaufort County, we hope to provide residents and tourists alike an expanded appreciation of just how lovely a place this is," said Steve Wilson, Chairman of the Southern Beaufort County Corridor Beautification Board.

"The Belfair community is very proud to lead the way by initiating the first section of landscaping along U.S. Highway 278," said Karen Renshaw, President of the Belfair Plantation Board. "We hope other communities and the general public will join us in working with the Beautification Board in their efforts."

The Southern Beaufort County Corridor Beautification Board is currently working with Tanger Outlets to landscape the medians in front of those properties. It is anticipated that the transformation will be completed later this year. The Beautification Board, appointed by Beaufort County Council, has a mission to fully landscape all the primary medians in the southern part of the County.

Valley Crest Landscaping was contracted to complete this project in front of Belfair Plantation. They began work April 20, 2015 and are expected to finish by the end of next week.
