## **Beaufort County Explores Possibility of a Mobile App**

Beaufort County launched a mobile applications (app) survey today, as part of its efforts to enhance accessibility, responsiveness, and efficiency in its programs and services.

"We are pleased to explore the possibility of a mobile app for the public," said Josh Riley, Beaufort County's Web Design and Content Manager. "The survey gives the County a tool to help gauge the elements for a mobile app, while allowing citizens and visitors an opportunity to share what they need and expect."

A mobile app can simplify the Beaufort County experience for the public and better connect them to essential information and services from anywhere, anytime on their mobile device.

"Understanding that many citizens rely on smartphones to power their day, we expect most responses will indicate they want the ability to receive notifications about events, pay property taxes, or report issues such as overgrown lots and stray animals," said Monica Spells, Assistant County Administrator for Civic Engagement.
