## License Renewals for Solid Waste Collectors and Haulers Due September 1

Solid waste collectors and haulers operating in Beaufort County must renew their solid waste hauler license with the County by September 1, 2015. Beaufort County's Code of Ordinances requires that all businesses or contractors providing residential, commercial, or industrial waste collection and transportation within the County have a license.

Beaufort County will not accept disposal charges at its approved landfills from collectors and haulers who do not have a valid license after the deadline. Collectors and haulers are also required to possess a solid waste disposal vehicle permit for each of the vehicles in their fleet traveling within the County.

Licenses and decals can be obtained from the Beaufort County Public Works office located at 120 Shanklin Road in Beaufort. The County held an informational meeting June 23, 2015, and mailed letters to collectors and haulers July 1, 2015.
