The Beaufort County Parks and Leisure Services (PALS) Department will provide free lunch to kids and teens this summer, as part of the U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) Summer Food Service Program (SFSP). Each year, the USDA Food and Nutrition Service partners with local organizations like Beaufort County PALS to provide free meals to children when school is out for the summer.
