## **End of Redemption Period Approaching**

The <u>Beaufort County Treasurer's Office</u> will be contacting delinquent real property owners whose property was sold at the 2015 tax sale, to notify them that the redemption period will be ending. Notices will be issued by mail in accordance with <u>South Carolina State Statute §12-51-120</u>.

These notices will be mailed to delinquent property owners, mortgagees, and/or lessees of the property of the record. These parties will have until 5 p.m. on Thursday, October 6, 2016, to redeem the property by paying all taxes, fees and penalties owed. Taxes may be paid by mail or at any of the <a href="https://documents.com/these-superscripts">https://documents.com/these-superscripts</a>.

According to the Treasurer's Office, once the redemption period has ended, there is very little recourse for the property owner and their property will be titled to the winning bidder.
