Due to the effects of Hurricane Matthew, all Beaufort County government offices, to include convenience centers, will remain closed on Monday, October 10, 2016. Further, all Beaufort County Council meetings scheduled for Monday, October 10, 2016, have been canceled.

The County anticipates offices will return to normal operating hours on Tuesday, October 11, 2016, subject to a review of environmental conditions. County employees should contact their supervisor for further instructions. Emergency services and law enforcement will remain available.
