Two Disaster Recovery Centers Open in Beaufort County

Two Disaster Recovery Centers are now open in Beaufort County. The Federal Emergency Management Agency and the South Carolina Emergency Management Division have selected two sites - one in Beaufort and one on Hilton Head Island - for Beaufort County residents.

The centers are established as one-stop shops to assist individuals applying for Individual Assistance through FEMA. Specialists from FEMA, the <u>U.S. Small Business Administration</u> and other agencies are on hand at both DRCs to answer questions and provide information on the types of assistance available.
