Due to the inclement weather forecasted, Beaufort County Administrator Gary Kubic has announced that all County government offices will be closed on Friday, September 2, 2016, and resume normal operating hours on Tuesday, September 6, 2016. Emergency services and law enforcement will remain available.

<u>Tropical Storm Hermine</u> is expected to impact our area Thursday afternoon into Thursday evening, lasting through the overnight hours into early Friday afternoon.
