Daufuskie Island Ferry Service to Relocate to Buckingham Landing

The County's embarkation location for public ferry service to Daufuskie Island will relocate Monday, Feb. 13, to Buckingham Landing at 35 Fording Island Road Extension in Bluffton.

After damages to the original embarkation site at Palmetto Bay Marina, the site was first relocated to Oyster Factory Park Landing. To expedite the transition to the new site at Buckingham Landing, the County's ferry services contractor, Daufuskie Island Ferry Service, LLC, will provide complimentary shuttle service between the parking lots at Oyster Factory Park Landing and Buckingham Landing from Feb. 11 through Feb. 15.

For example, passengers taking the ferry on Monday can get off at Buckingham Landing where a shuttle will take them to their car at the Oyster Factory Park Landing. When they return for a ferry ride, they should park at Buckingham Landing.

Directions to Buckingham Landing

From Bluffton

Go east on U.S. Highway 278. Watch for the BP Gas Station and Wesley's Fruit Stand on your right. Take a slight right turn onto Fording Island Road Extension and continue to the end.

From Hilton Head Island

Take U.S. Highway 278 West to Fording Island Road Extension. Watch for the BP Gas Station and Wesley's Fruit Stand on your left. Take a sharp left onto Fording Island Road Extension, which ends at the landing.
