County Treasurer's Office Mails Delinquent Tax Bills

The Beaufort County Treasurer's Office has mailed 24,755 delinquent property tax bills for the tax year 2016 totaling approximately \$23 million. Delinquent tax bills, as well as all other bills and County correspondence from the Treasurer's Office, are mailed through the United States Postal Service to addresses on record with Beaufort County.

Taxpayers are reminded to always keep a current mailing address on file with the Treasurer's Office for each real and personal property they own. Taxpayers can easily <u>update their mailing address</u> and <u>pay delinquent property taxes online</u>, by mail or in-person. According to Beaufort County Treasurer Maria Walls, CPA, the mailing of delinquent property tax bills is the first step in the delinquency process to notify delinquent owners about their outstanding taxes.
