New Coastal Kingdom Episode to Focus on Lowcountry Conservation

A new episode of The County Channel's award-winning nature series, *Coastal Kingdom* will air this Sunday, June 18 at 8 p.m. The episode, *Lowcountry Conservation*, will feature some of the hard-working scientists doing research in the field to help preserve and protect our local wildlife.
