Veterans Day Parade and Ceremony November 11

<u>The Beaufort County Department of Veterans Affairs</u> and the Beaufort Veterans Day Planning Committee is hosting the 2017 Veterans Day Parade and Ceremony on Saturday, November 11.

The parade will begin at 9:30 a.m. and follow a route through downtown Beaufort, beginning at Rodgers Street and Boundary Street, by the <u>Beaufort National Cemetery</u>.
