CERT Classes for December

Beaufort County residents interested in learning more about self-sufficiency during a disaster are invited to participate in the Community Response Team Program. The CERT program provides training for individuals to increase self-sufficiency in a disaster. Participants will learn to provide emergency assistance to their families and neighbors. CERT classes are free of charge. The next series will start December 5. Classes will be held at the Technical College of the Lowcountry campus in Bluffton at 100 Community College Drive in room 125.

The course is taught in four class sessions 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. and one Saturday exercise class 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.:

Thursday, December 7th -- Disaster Medical I

Tuesday, December 12th -- Disaster Psychology/Terrorism Response

Thursday, December 14th -- Disaster Medical II / CERT Organization

Saturday, December 16th -- Fire Suppression / Disaster Search Techniques Exercise
