New County Stormwater Permit Requirements Take Effect April 1

UPDATE: New Stormwater Permit Requirements took effect October 2018. Details are available <u>here</u>.

Starting April 1, Beaufort County will require any land disturbance necessitating a zoning or development permit application to have an associated stormwater permit. Limited exceptions may apply for some properties.

The review and issuance of a local stormwater permit and zoning permit begins with submission of an application to the <u>Community Development Department</u>, typically as part of a zoning or development permit application. Additionally, applicants developing a lot must get an applicable Notice of Intent (permit) from the <u>South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control</u>.

Applicants should review the County's Manual for Stormwater Best Management and Design Practices (<u>BMP Manual</u>) for additional information, including clarification regarding exceptions, requirements for an application, fee schedule, and submittal requirements.
