## **Beaufort County Treasurer's Office Mails Delinquent Tax Bills**

According to a news release, the Beaufort County Treasurer's Office has mailed 23,791 delinquent property tax bills for the 2017 tax year totaling approximately \$23 million.

According to Beaufort County Treasurer Maria Walls, CPA, sending delinquent tax bills to taxpayers with outstanding balances on their real and personal property is the first step in the delinquency process. Consequently, taxpayers should pay their taxes immediately to avoid additional fees and future collection notifications.

Additionally, taxpayers should ensure that their mailing address is current with the Treasurer's Office for all real and personal property owned. Delinquent tax bills, as well as all other bills and County correspondence, are mailed to the address on record with Beaufort County through the United States Postal Service.

Taxpayers can <u>update their mailing address</u> and <u>pay any delinquent property taxes</u> online, by mail, or in person at <u>any location of the Treasurer's Office</u>.
