## Both Locations of the Beaufort County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Department Closed Morning of June 22 for Staff Training

The Beaufort and Bluffton locations of the Beaufort County Alcohol and Drug Abuse Department will be closed from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Friday, June 22. All department staff members will be participating in a training opportunity hosted by the New Life Center, which is based in neighboring Hampton County. Both agencies develop and manage outpatient services to prevent and reduce the negative health, social, and economic consequences resulting from addiction and co-dependency.

Both agencies are affiliates of the South Carolina Department of Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse Services (<u>DAODAS</u>), which coordinates a statewide system of local substance abuse agencies that provide prevention, treatment, and recovery services. The mission of DAODAS is to ensure the availability and quality of a continuum of substance use services, thereby improving the health status, safety, and quality of life of individuals, families, and communities across South Carolina.
