A decision regarding meetings scheduled to occur later in the week is pending weather conditions.

As of right now, County offices are scheduled to open tomorrow according to their normal operating schedules.

Although the current track shows the storm making landfall in North Carolina, Beaufort County remains in the cone of uncertainty. Residents and guests should continue to plan for impacts associated with the storm as it moves closer.
