- Call to Order: Chairman Dietz called the meeting to order at 2:00 pm.
- Agenda: The Agenda was approved as written.
- **Minutes:** The minutes of September 22, 2011 minutes were approved noting the following corrections:
 - o **Monthly Reports Item 8 to :** Mr. Minor noted that there was no single stream recycling 2 years ago. This new collection method now captures almost 400 tons p/month.
 - o **Daufuskie Island Convenience Center to:** Mr. McFee reported that the Court of Appeals hearing was held on the center. All briefs and information were presented and a response is expected in 45 days.
- **Introductions:** All present were introduced. Mr. Dietz welcomed Ben Wheatley, the new District 7 Representative, replacing Gordon Bowers.
- **Public Comment:** Mr. Dietz called for public comment. There being none, the meeting continued.

Monthly Reports

Mike Bennett, I2Recycle

o SW&R Monthly Reports:

- o Mr. Minor reviewed the September 2011 reports including the Tonnage Map in each district. Mr. Dietz asked if population numbers could be added to the map by district.
- o Total Tonnage for September was 5,071 tons.
- o Total September disposal costs were \$196,899. Total hauling costs were \$46,871. Related budgets are on target.
- o Traffic flow was noted 133,040 with anomalies continuing in our counter system.
- o September recycling includes 369.53 tons curbside, 274.92 tons from centers. Total to date residential including newspapers was 701.63 tons.
- o Total September recycling costs were \$67,252 noting budget expended19%.
- o Recycling proceeds for the year includes: \$52,899 in Credits from our contract with Waste Management, \$83,612 in revenue from scrap metal, newspaper, oil, etc.

• Litter Officers' Reports

- o Mrs. Murphy reported that the replacement officer for Cpl Black would arrive after 1/1/12 after completing the academy.
- o The Litter Officers report contained the latest *illegal dump of the month* or typical ditch dumping.

• Coordinators' Report

- o The public was reminded of the next Ewaste and Shredding event to be held 11/5/2011.
- o County Office Recycling program Average Weekly collection holding at @ 1200lbs
- Mrs. Murphy noted that the county would be participating in America Recycles Day again on 11/15. The public was reminded that recycling also has environmental and economic benefits.
