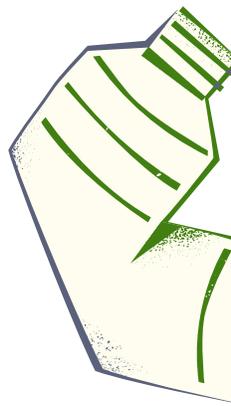
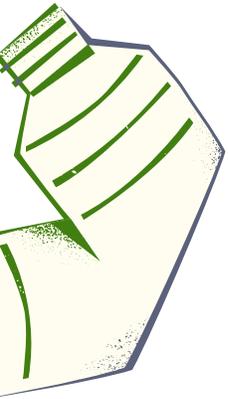


Beaufort County Solid Waste & Recycling Art Contest

Contest Rules

Submissions & Entry:

Artwork requirements:

Design must include recycling theme. Must be original design of student. No copyrighted or syndicated characters. All artwork will become property of Beaufort County Solid Waste & Recycling Department. Designs are to be completed in provided artwork space. The use of Beaufort County recycling mascot-Rerun is encouraged (Bag and Blue too).

Materials:

Students may use a variety of materials such as paints, markers, pen, crayons, and media graphics. Brighter colors are encouraged for visibility of billboard. Landscape layout is preferred.

Judging:

1. Convey clear message about recycling through text and artwork.
2. Shows creativity, artistic ability, and originality.
3. Bright, bold, colorful, and easy to understand- displays well on a billboard.
4. Recycling theme is evident in artwork.

Awards:

Each grade level will receive a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner. All winners will receive a reusable water bottle. Grand prize winner's artwork will be displayed on a billboard in Beaufort County.
