III. Old Business:

- **A. Hobbit Hill Daycare Center:** Robert Merchant gave the background. Don Guscio, the projects landscape architect and site planner gave the presentation. Wayne Ramsey motioned to approve the project's architecture with the following conditions:
 - The slope of the roof is set at 4:12 at the gable ends and 2:12 in the center portion.
 - If shutters are used, they shall be operable.

IV. New Business:

A. Lady's Island Airport PUD RV Park: Robert Merchant gave the background. Dave Karlyk of Andrews Engineering gave the presentation. The Board chose to review the project. Dorie Eckard motioned to give the project final approval with the following conditions:

- Perimeter buffers will be established according to the requirements in Appendix B of the ZDSO.
- Existing plant materials in the buffer will saved. Planting will occur only where there are gaps in the buffer.
- The trees required to be planted in the parking areas will be transferred to the buffer.
- Evergreen vine will be planted to grow on the perimeter fence.
- If irrigation is not used, new plant materials will be installed in autumn when rainfall will assist in establishing the new plants.
