- The landscaping plan needs to be revised to clearly show the location of planted materials and to contain a detailed plant list that indicates the quantity, size at time of planting, species and cultivar of each proposed plant material.
- The size of the porch needs to be increased so that the roof ridge ties in with the main roof ridge. The building needs to incorporate a cupola or other element to break up the monotony of the roof.
- The applicant needs to provide cut sheets of the proposed outdoor lighting fixture planned for

the porch area of the building. Any other proposed outdoor fixtures need to be presented to the Board.

• The conditions specified above need to be presented to the Corridor Review Board prior to the commencement of any site work.

John Pinckney seconded. Motion carried.

Modern Classic Motors: Robert Merchant gave the project background. Dale Johnson, the project architect, gave the presentation. The Board took no action but gave the following comments:

- The applicant should consider the use of a pervious asphalt material.
- The Board generally looked favorably on this project.
