- **II. Review of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting:** Todd O'Dell motioned to approve the minutes of the September 9, 2002 meeting. John Pinckney seconded. Motion carried
- **III.** General Public Comment: There was no public comment.

IV. Old Business:

- **A.** Low Country Village Phase I: Robert Merchant gave the project background. Chris Nardone of Corcoran, Nelson, Nardone gave the presentation. The Board took no action, but offered the following comments:
 - The quantity of lighting fixture "A" needs to be cut in half.
 - More landscaping is needed along the elevation that faces U.S. 278.
 - ♦ The landscaping plan needs to incorporate tall canopy trees and palmettos along the front and U.S. 278 elevations of the building.
 - ◆ The Board expressed concerns about the linear monolithic design of the building and offered the following suggestions to add interest and definition:
 - 1. Incorporate pilasters at the sides of the entrance elements and at the corners of the building.
 - 2. Provide elements along the parapet walls between tenants such as louvers, shutters or the use of a different materials and colors.
 - 3. Add a vertical element along the parapet wall between tenant spaces.
