SOUTHERN BEAUFORT COUNTY CORRIDOR REVIEW BOARD MINUTES April 3, 2006

The Corridor Review Board met at the Holiday Inn Express in Bluffton, SC at 2:30 P.M.

- I. Call to Order: Chairman Beste called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m.
- **II.** General Public Comment: There was no public comment.
- **III. Review of CRB Minutes:** The Board approved the February 20, 2006, March 6, 2006 and March 20, 2006 minutes as submitted.

IV. Old Business:

- A. **Goodyear Store Okatie (Final):** Jim Tiller recused himself from project review. Steve Wilson motioned to approve the project with the following conditions:
 - 1. Raise the shed dormers to increase reveal.
 - 2. Provide the ARB approval letter.
 - 3. Provide cut sheets for lighting.
 - 4. Dumpster location approved. It will be the same brick as the building.

Martha Crapse seconded. Motion carried. The changes will be submitted to staff for approval.

- **B.** Grease Monkey Myrtle Park (Final): Steve Wilson motioned for final approval with the following conditions:
 - 1. Light fixtures shall have solid lenses. No illumination may be visible and have a solid hood. No visible lenses.

Jim Tiller seconded. Motion carried.

V. New Business:

- A. Ethan Allen Okatie Crossing (Conceptual): The Board made the following recommendations:
 - 1. 8' foundation (landscape) buffer required around the building. Side walks can cross the buffer but may not be included as a part of the buffer.
 - 2. The roof architecture needs to incorporate pitched roof elements to break up the elevation. The entire roof does not need to be pitched.
 - 3. Provide building material and awning samples at next meeting. Board can not approve printed color samples.
 - 4. Dumpster will need to be appropriately landscaped to reduce its view.
 - 5. Internally illuminated signs are not allowed.
 - 6. Board is concerned about the views into the site from the highway. Provide information showing existing vegetation (typically shown on plan and with photos).
 - 7. Canopies can not be up lit.

The Board agreed the applicant could proceed to final if they wished.
