Administrative Parking Lot – **Additional Consultant Services**; Andrews and Burgess; \$5,000; extra engineering associated with pervious pavement and contractor demo assistance and paving contract supervision.

FY 2012-FY2013 Annual Monitoring Contract; GEL Engineering; \$95,094; This was delayed to address questions about the overall program and an short Change Order for one month was issued. Now plan to bring contract to the Natural Resources Committee on November 7, 2011.

Assistance with Water Budget Study: GEL Engineer; \$10,000; Two \$5,000 level of effort proposals were requested to support this study. One would be to assist in setting up weirs and monitoring wells and the other will be to provide technical support for monitoring equipment as needed. It is not expected to cost this much.

Step 2 Exemption Review for Habersham: CDM: est \$2,000; Assist Utility in reviewing this submission. Should be last assistance request.

Projects Funded since Last Report - BMP Manual Upgrades as part of Reformating: CDM; *Task 4 – Establish peak flow reduction credit associated with volume control BMPs.* \$9,300 will review the current requirements for peak flow design requirements, and techniques used by engineers to demonstrate compliance with the requirements. Will then determine an appropriate method of incorporating the benefits of the stormwater runoff volume control features into the techniques used by the engineers. Discussing additional staff comments and link to 100 year flood design.

Should note that reformatted BMP Manual has been received (September) but Bob Klink and Dan Ahern decided to wait to include input from these upgrades before publishing. Have sent out reformatted BMP to local engineers for additional input on reformatting.
