Responsibilities and duties.

(a)

Review and recommend to the county council for approval, a comprehensive Beaufort County Stormwater Management Master Plan and appropriate utility rate study which is in accordance with the South Carolina Stormwater Management and Sediment Reduction Act; and

(b)

Review and comment to the county administrator on the annual stormwater management utility enterprise fund budget; and

(c)

Cooperate with the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC), Office of Coastal Resource Management (OCRM), the Oversight Committee of the Special Area Management Plan (SAMP), the Beaufort County Clean Water Task Force as well as other public and private agencies having programs directed toward stormwater management programs; and

(d)

Review and make recommendations concerning development of a multiyear stormwater management capital improvement project (CIP) plan; and

(e)

Review and advise on proposed stormwater management plans and procurement procedures; and

(f)

Provide review and recommendations on studies conducted and/or funded by the utility; and

(g)

Review and advise on actions and programs to comply with regulatory requirements, including permits issued under the State of South Carolina National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Storm Water Discharges from Regulated Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4).
