

When America's veterans and their families need help securing the benefits they earned, our volunteer corps stands ready to assist them. We recruit and train *pro bono* professionals, and work with Service Officers match them with veterans who cannot afford legal representation or professional services—100% free of charge. The Veterans Consortium Pro Bono Program is an independent nonprofit resource for Service Officers that provides all qualifying veterans and their loved ones or survivors from across the country free representation at the Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims, and the Federal Circuit and Supreme Court as needed. We also provide related *pro bono* medical services.



Since accepting our first veteran client in 1992, our nonprofit's staff and nationwide volunteer corps have:

- √ helped 12,571 veterans and their families,
- √ won 3,614 federal court cases for deserving clients—a
  nearly 80% lifetime win rate,
- ✓ recruited and trained 3,585 volunteers to provide *probono* professional services,
- √ provided a valuable Helpline that provides legal information to veterans,
- ✓ initiated a *pro bono* Medical Project for independent medical advice to our clients, and
- √ delivered pro bono legal and professional services valued at more than 88 million dollars.

We help Service Officers ensure that all veterans, and their loved ones or survivors, can receive the benefits and care they earned by serving our country.
