Beaufort Office Open Sunday, March 27, 2016 for Candidate Filing

The Board of Voter Registration and Elections of Beaufort County Beaufort office **only** will be open **Sunday, March 27, 2016, 1:00 pm – 5:00 pm** for candidate filing. The Beaufort office is located at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, SC 29906.

Candidates have until Noon, Wednesday, March 30, 2016 to file. Filing can be done in the Beaufort or Bluffton office.

The Beaufort office is located at 15 John Galt Road, Beaufort, SC 29906 and is open for filing Monday – Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.

The Bluffton office is located at 61B Ulmer Road, Bluffton, SC 29910 and will be open for filing Monday – Wednesday, March 30, 2016, 8:00 am – 4:00 pm.

Filing Form: The Statement of Intention of Candidacy & Party Pledge (SICPP) form required for filing is available in the “Candidate Information” section of scVOTES.org and at the election commission office.

Filing Fee: Filing fees are paid at the time of filing by candidates seeking the nomination of a party nominating by primary. The list of filing fees is available at scVOTES.org and at the election commission office. Filing fee checks should be made payable to the appropriate state political party. A candidate seeking the nomination of a party nominating by convention does not pay a filing fee.

State Ethics Filings: Candidates are required to file a Statement of Economic Interests and a Campaign Disclosure online with the State Ethics Commission at <http://ethics.sc.gov>.

Failure to file these documents may result in a candidate fine but will not disqualify a candidate from the election. Contact the State Ethics Commission for more information.
