

Ancillary Polling Location South of Broad

- Conditions favorable for county-owned solution
 - Evaluating two to three sites over the next 2 weeks...
 will prioritize suitability and provide ranking to county administrator
- Pending legislation may have a bearing





SC House Bill 3418

- □ Voter ID / Early Voting Bill
- Two versions
 - 1. House
 - Removes option for an ancillary location
 - Limits early voting period to 3 days...hours mandated
 - Deletes ability to request absentee ballot via telephone
 - Disallows use of voting machines for absentee voting

2. Senate

- Early voting is 15 to 3 days prior; county sets hours
- Allows voter to produce employee ID card w/ photo issued by federal gov't, State of SC, or political subdivision of SC
