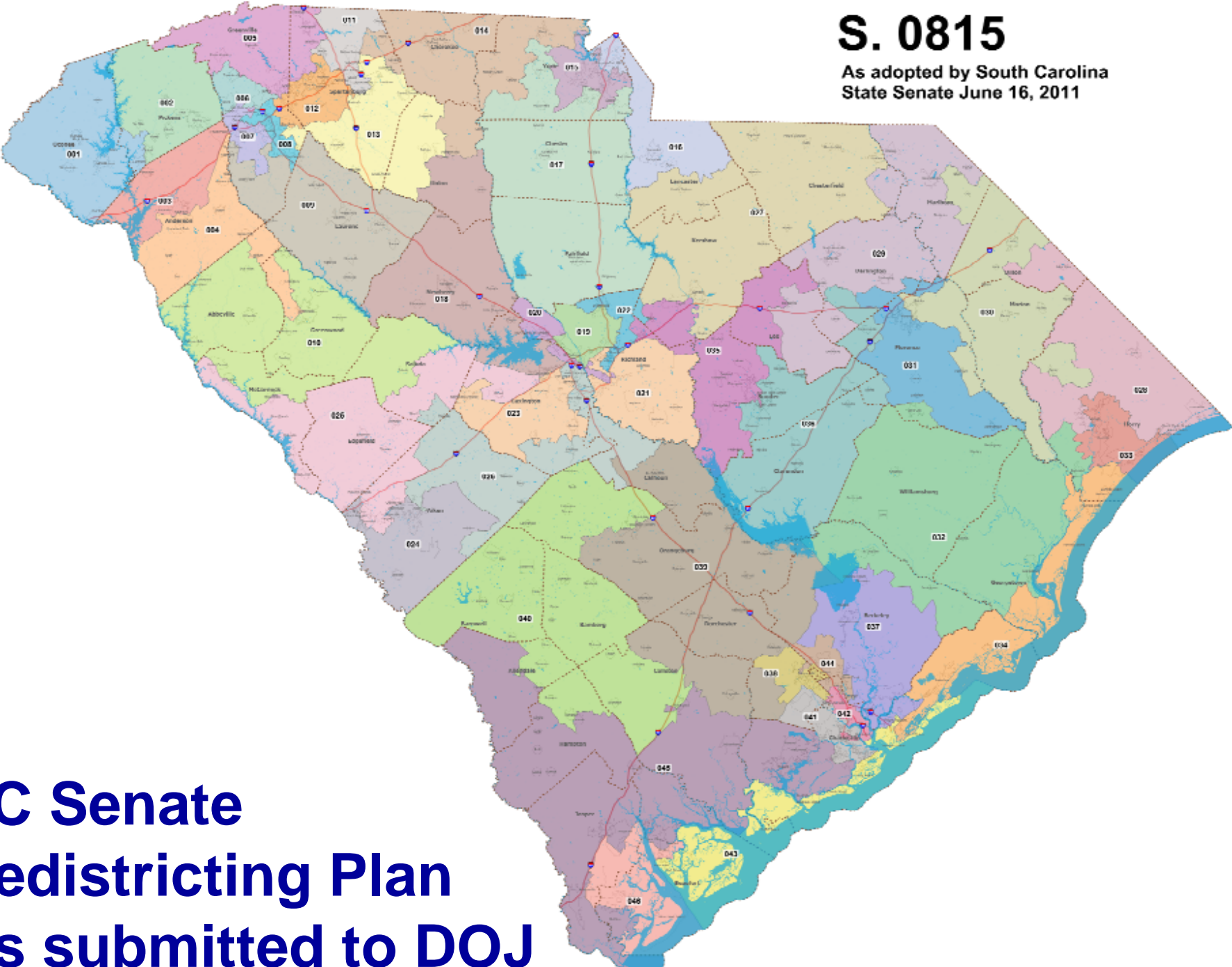

Status of Voter Photo ID Law

- DOJ requested additional information from SC AG on August 29
- SEC provided draft response for AG on September 13
- Straight Talk
 - Figure of 10,000 Beaufort County voters w/out photo ID did not come from this office
 - Registration requirements have not changed
 - Absentee voting rules remain unaffected

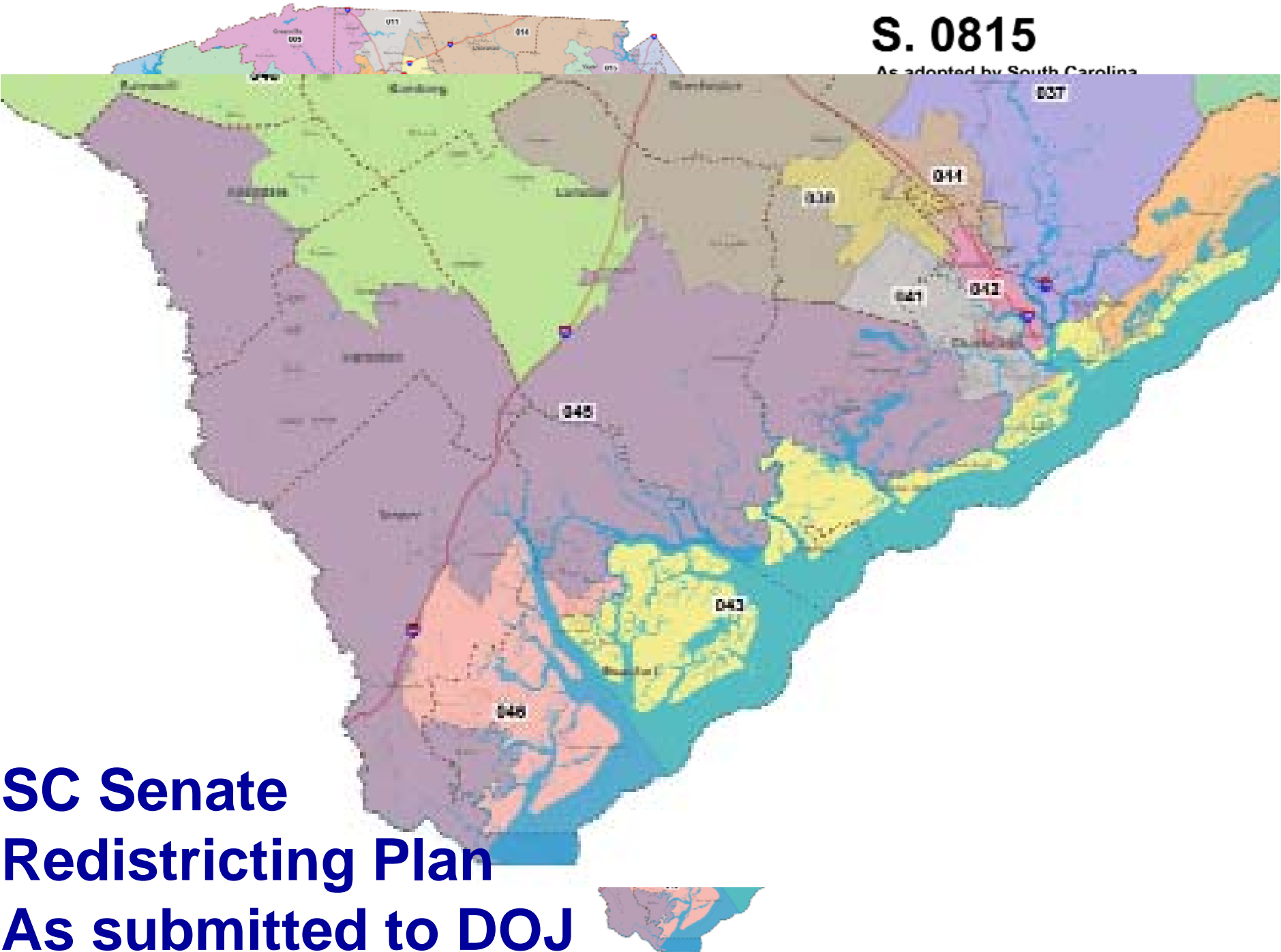

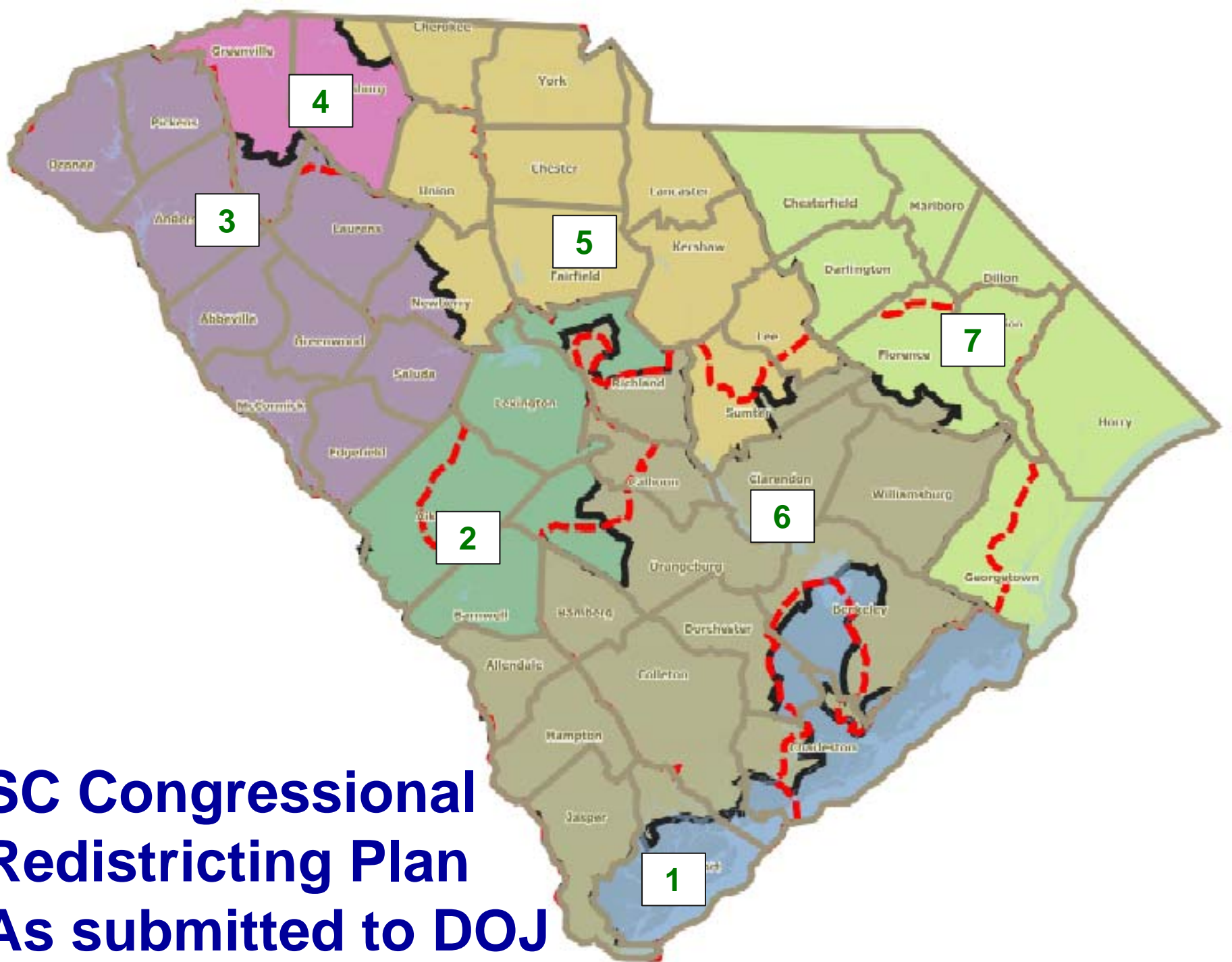

SC Senate Redistricting Plan As submitted to DOJ

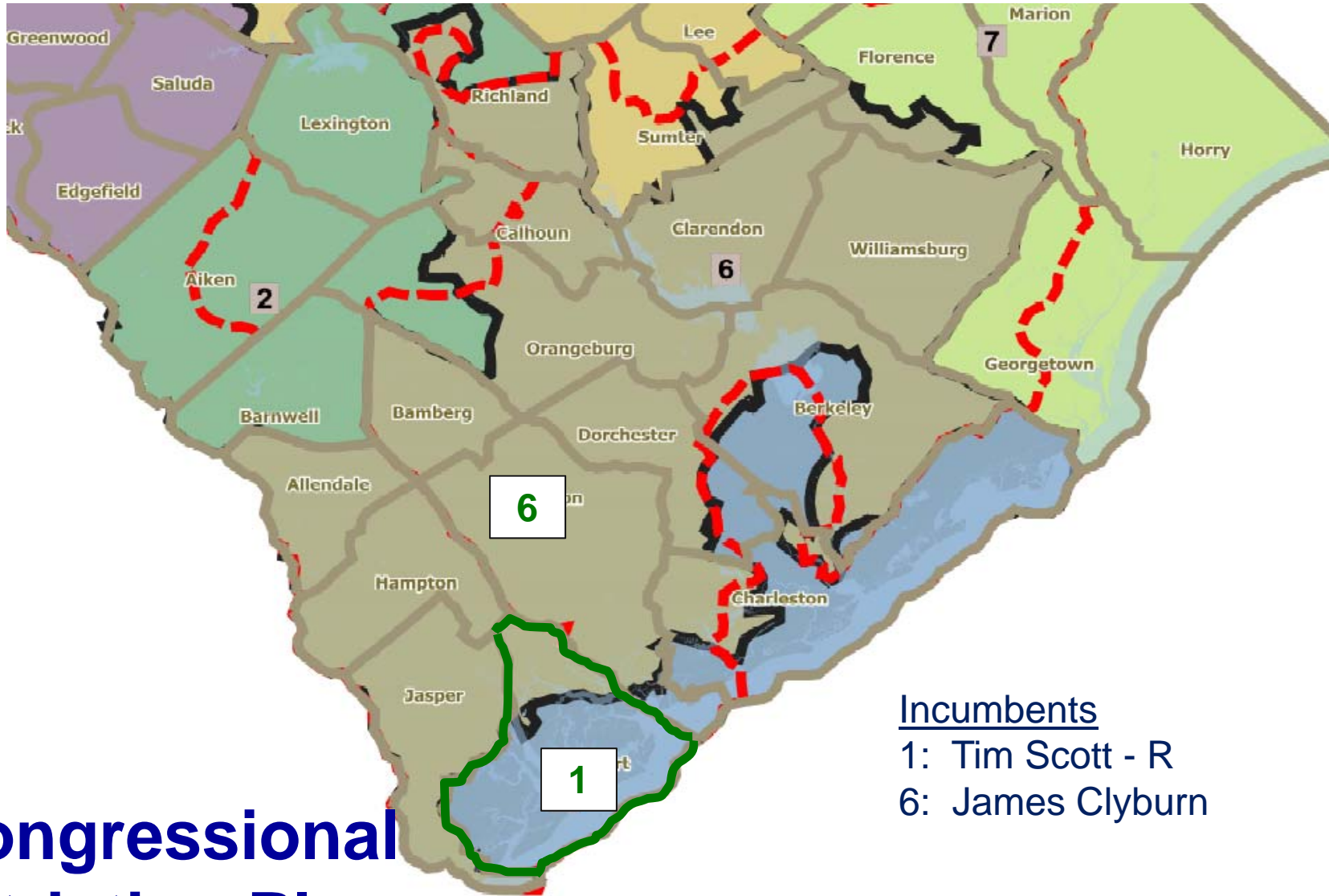

As submitted to DOJ

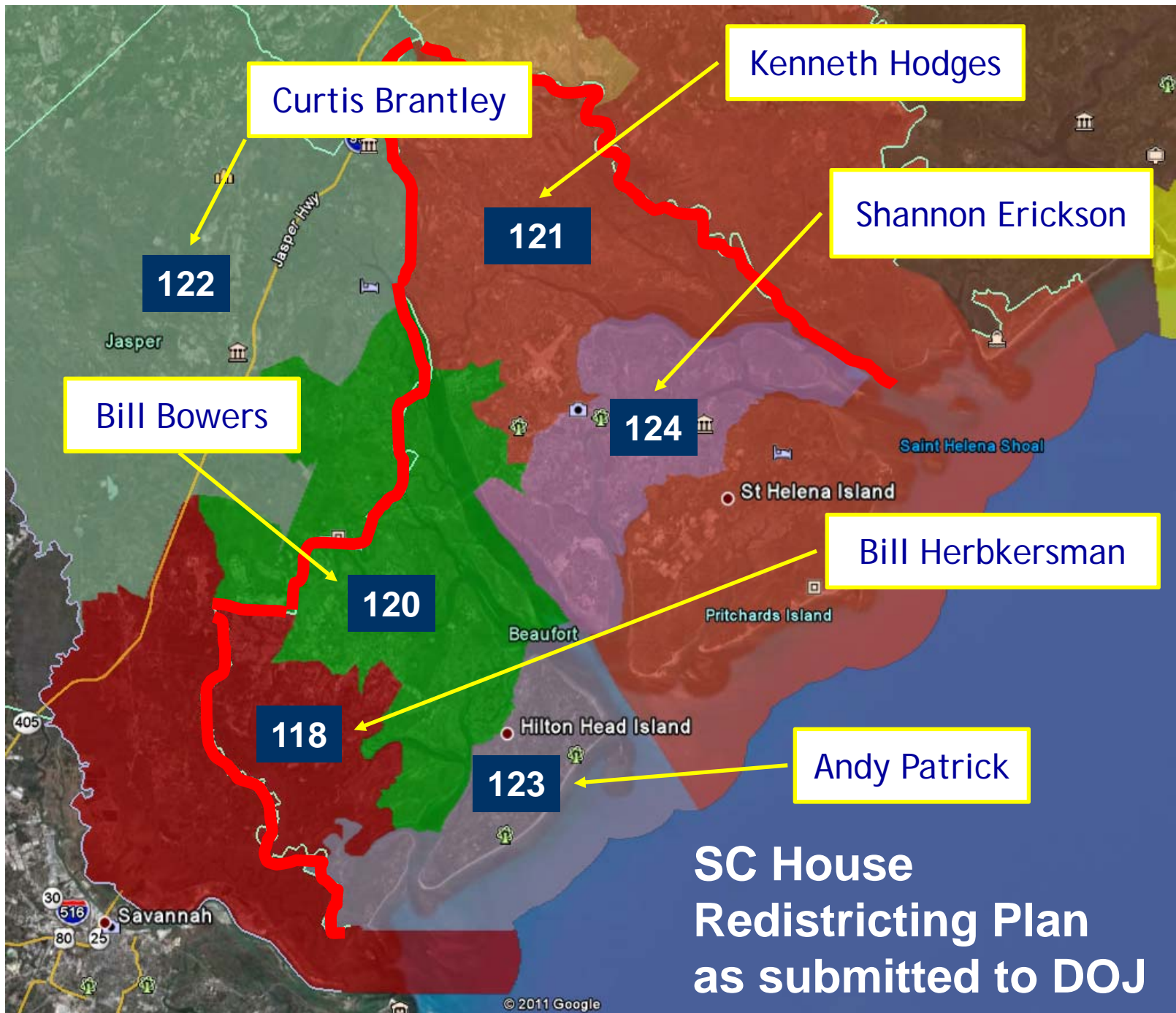

as submitted to DOJ**



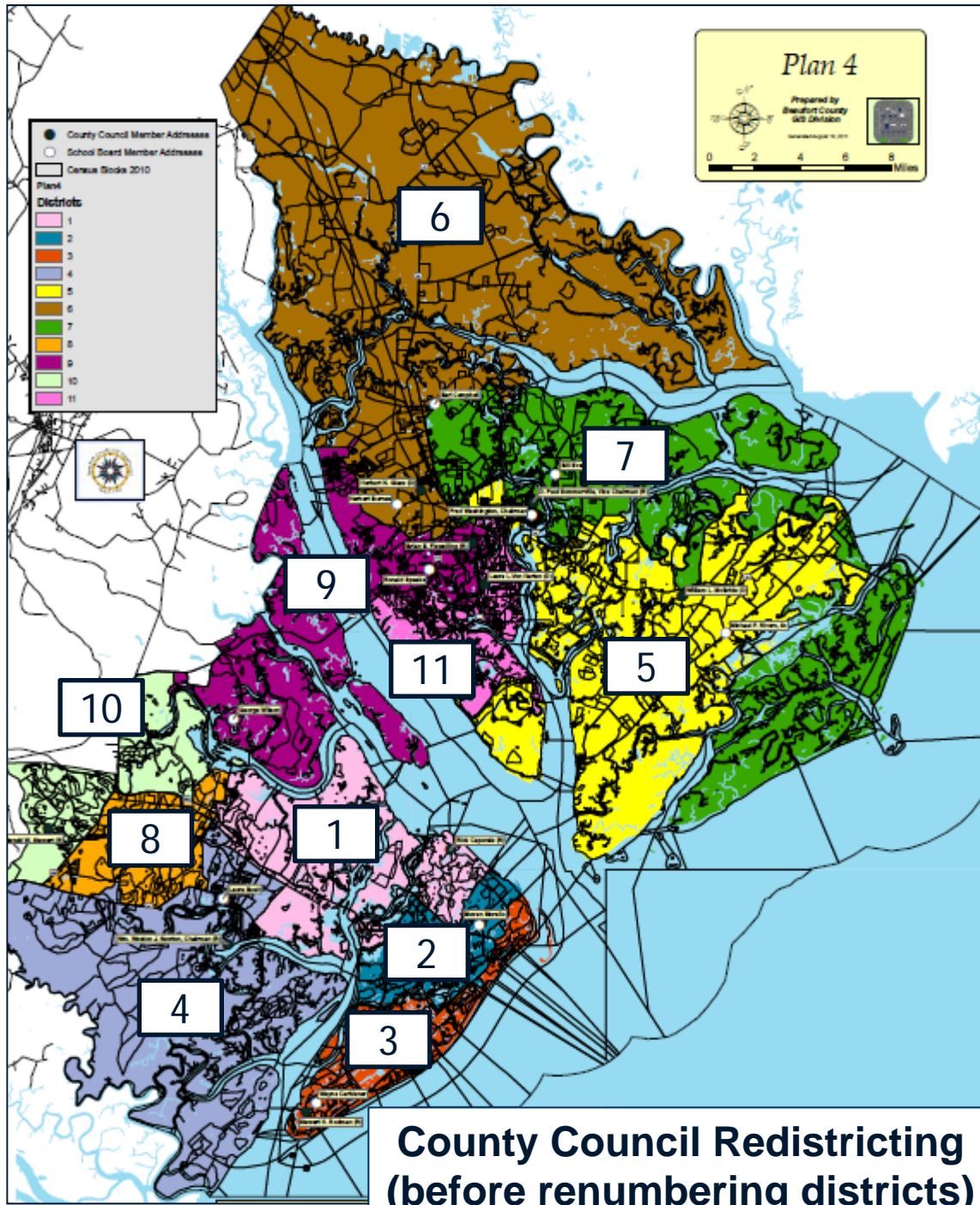

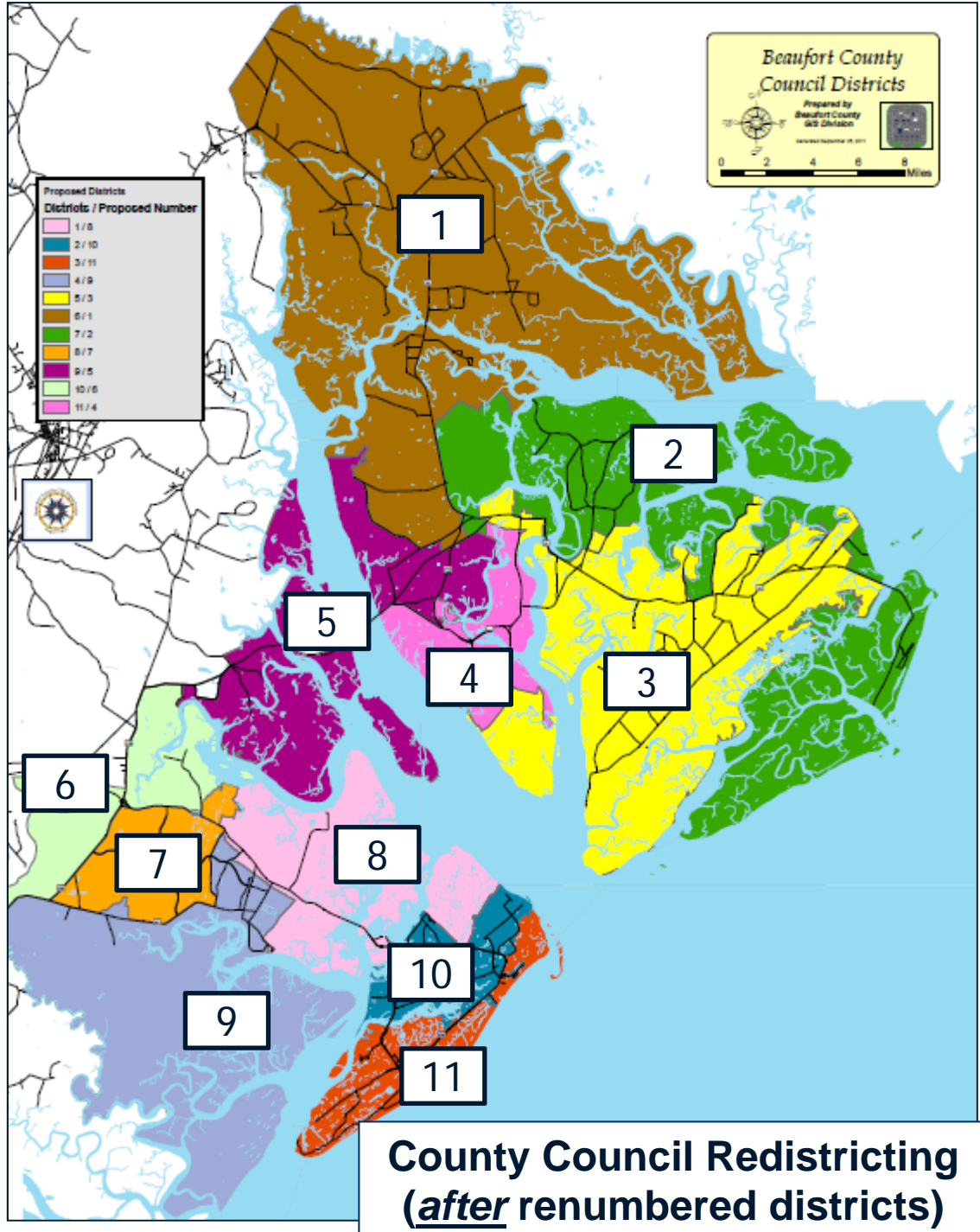
